## National Council on Compensation Insurance Filing *Item E-1406*

The subject of this order is the adoption of amendments to the National Council on Compensation Insurance (NCCI) *Experience Rating Plan Manual for Workers Compensation and Employers Liability Insurance* (Experience Rating Plan), as proposed in *Item E-1406--Revisions to the ERM-14 Form and Rule 3-A in the Experience Rating Plan Manual* (TDI ECase No. 22090; SERFF Tracking No. NCCI-132044671).

#### **Background**

NCCI filed *Item E-1406* to amend the NCCI Experience Rating Plan.

The amendments revise the Confidential Request for Ownership Information form (ERM-14) by changing the title and reformatting, shortening, and clarifying the wording so it is easier to understand. The reference to the form in Rule 3-A is also being updated.

A change in ownership of an individual employer may affect the loss experience used in calculating the experience rating modification. NCCI may issue, retract, or revise the current modification, and up to two preceding modifications, due to ownership changes. Generally, the experience of the business will be transferred to the new owner. These changes may also result in a change to the rating effective date.

When a change in ownership occurs, the employer must notify the insurer in writing within 90 days of the date of the change. This can be done by submitting an ERM-14 form to the insurer.

After considering the filing, TDI adopts the following findings of fact and conclusions of law.

#### **Findings of Fact**

- 1. NCCI filed *Item E-1406* with TDI on August 22, 2019, under the workers' compensation manual rule filing procedure adopted in Commissioner's Order No. 3142, dated March 21, 2014.
- 2. *Item E-1406* amends the Experience Rating Plan to revise the Confidential Request for Ownership Information form (ERM-14) by changing the title, reformatting, shortening, and clarifying the wording so it is easier to understand. The reference to the form in Rule 3-A is also being updated.
- 3. The ERM-14 form was last updated in 2003. In 2017, NCCI automated the ERM-14 form submission process. Based on feedback from stakeholders, NCCI determined it was also necessary to improve the accuracy and completeness of the form. This filing accomplishes this by reducing the form's length and clarifying the wording so it is easier to understand.
- 4. NCCI proposed that the changes in *Item E-1406* apply to new and renewal workers' compensation policies that are effective on or after 12:01 a.m. on February 1, 2020.
- 5. *Item E-1406* has been available for public inspection in SERFF and at TDI since the filing date.
- 6. The filing, including exhibits, is incorporated by reference into this order.
- 7. On December 16, 2019, TDI published notice of the filing on the TDI website at www.tdi.texas.gov/rules/2019/nccimanual.html and distributed notice of the filing to electronic news subscribers.
- 8. TDI did not receive written comments or hearing requests on the filing by the January 21, 2020, deadline.
- 9. Because the proposed effective date of *Item E-1406* has passed, TDI has changed the date to apply to new and renewal workers' compensation policies that are effective on or after 12:01 a.m. on June 1, 2020.

#### **Conclusions of Law**

- 1. TDI has jurisdiction over this matter under Insurance Code Article 5.96 and §§ 2051.002, 2051.201, 2052.002, 2053.002, 2053.011, 2053.051, 2053.052, 2053.053, and 36.001.
- 2. TDI gave notice in compliance with Commissioner's Order No. 3142.
- 3. The amendments to the NCCI Experience Rating Plan are consistent with Insurance Code Article 5.96 and Chapters 2051, 2052, and 2053.
- 4. Because the proposed effective date of Item E-1406 has passed, a later effective date is necessary.
- 5. Applying the changes in *Item E-1406* to new and renewal workers' compensation policies that are effective on or after 12:01 a.m. on June 1, 2020, is reasonable.

#### Order

It is ordered that NCCI's filing, *Item E-1406*, is approved. The changes in *Item E-1406* apply to new and renewal workers' compensation policies that are effective on or after 12:01 a.m. on June 1, 2020.

#### ELECTRONIC RECORD AND SIGNATURE DISCLOSURE

From time to time, Carahsoft oboTexas Department of Insurance (we, us or Company) may be required by law to provide to you certain written notices or disclosures. Described below are the terms and conditions for providing to you such notices and disclosures electronically through the DocuSign system. Please read the information below carefully and thoroughly, and if you can access this information electronically to your satisfaction and agree to this Electronic Record and Signature Disclosure (ERSD), please confirm your agreement by selecting the check-box next to 'I agree to use electronic records and signatures' before clicking 'CONTINUE' within the DocuSign system.

#### Getting paper copies

At any time, you may request from us a paper copy of any record provided or made available electronically to you by us. You will have the ability to download and print documents we send to you through the DocuSign system during and immediately after the signing session and, if you elect to create a DocuSign account, you may access the documents for a limited period of time (usually 30 days) after such documents are first sent to you. After such time, if you wish for us to send you paper copies of any such documents from our office to you, you will be charged a \$0.00 per-page fee. #### Withdrawing your consent

We will bill you for any fees at that time, if any.

#### To withdraw your consent with Carahsoft oboTexas Department of Insurance

To inform us that you no longer wish to receive future notices and disclosures in electronic format you may:

i. decline to sign a document from within your signing session, and on the subsequent page, select the check-box indicating you wish to withdraw your consent, or you may;

ii. send us an email to itslibrary@tdi.texas.gov and in the body of such request you must state your email, full name, mailing address, and telephone number. We do not need any other information from you to withdraw consent.. The consequences of your withdrawing consent for online documents will be that transactions may take a longer time to process..
