National Council on Compensation Insurance *Item 01-TX-2017*

Description:

- The National Council on Compensation Insurance (NCCI) filed *Item 01-TX-2017—Revisions to Domestic Classifications* on November 16, 2017. On December 4, 2017, NCCI amended the filing by submitting Exhibit 4, which revises national Appendix E to establish Code 0908 in Texas. This item proposes to:
 - Revise the Texas phraseology for Code 0913—Domestic Workers—Residences—
 Per Capita Basis to apply to only full-time domestic workers;
 - Eliminate the redundant Texas phraseology for Code 0913—Residences—
 Private—Domestic Workers—Per Capita Basis;
 - Establish a Texas phraseology for Code 0908—Domestic Workers—Residences— Part-Time;
 - Revise and eliminate several Texas exceptions in *Basic Manual* Rule 3-C to clarify application of the rule to full and part-time domestic workers; and
 - o Revise national Appendix E to establish Code 0908 in Texas.

Requested Effective Date:

The filing proposes that the changes in *Item 01-TX-2017* apply to new and renewal workers' compensation policies effective on and after July 1, 2019.
