# Official Order of the Texas Commissioner of Insurance

Date: <u>August 10, 2018</u>

## **Subject Considered:**

National Council on Compensation Insurance NCCI Filing Items B-1436(FD) and B-1436(RD) Amendments to Basic Manual Classifications

The Texas Department of Insurance considered amendments to the National Council on Compensation Insurance (NCCI) *Basic Manual for Workers Compensation and Employers Liability Insurance* proposed in *Items B-1436(FD)* and *B-1436(RD)* - *Revisions to Basic Manual Classifications and Appendix E - Classifications by Hazard Group* (TDI ECase No. 14981; SERFF Tracking Nos. NCCI-131257443; and NCCI-131260899).

After considering the filing, TDI adopts the following findings of fact and conclusions of law.

### **Findings of Fact**

- 1. NCCI filed *Items B-1436(FD)* and *B-1436(RD)* on November 14, 2017, using the procedure adopted in Commissioner's Order No. 3142 for revisions to NCCI's workers' compensation manuals.
- 2. On January 11, 2018, NCCI amended *Item B-1436(RD)* by submitting revised Exhibit Fact Sheet 3 to correct the inaccurate reference to Exhibit 3C instead of Exhibit 8 in the Texas proposal, number 4 on Page 33.
- 3. The amendments in *Item B-1436(FD)*:
  - a) Reformat the following special classifications for improved online search results:
    - i. Building Raising or Moving (Codes 5022, 5057, 5213, 5403);
    - ii. Farm (Codes 0005, 0008, 0011, 0016, 0035, 0037, 0079, 0083, 0113);
    - iii. Wrecking or Demolition—Not Marine (Codes 5022, 5057, 5213, 5403, 6003); and

- b) Eliminate the state special farm note because it is properly included in the Texas exception to NCCI's *Basic Manual for Workers Compensation and Employers Liability Insurance* Rule 1-D-3-e—Farm Operations.
- 4. The amendments in *Item B-1436(RD)* clarify the classification treatment for:
  - c) Retirement living centers and nursing homes by assigning healthcare employees of all types of operations to one classification and assigning all other employees to another classification;
  - d) Limousine and taxicab companies to indicate that garage employees be separately rated to Code 8385;
  - e) Digital photography operations by updating phraseologies to address photo developing and printing including digital media and establishing a new Code 8015 for document scanning and quick printing operations;
  - f) Manufacture, service, or repair, and the piloting of an unmanned aircraft system or drone aircraft by establishing new Code 8720 for employers piloting drone aircraft of less than 55 pounds for other businesses; and
  - g) Automobile body repair and automobile repair shops by revising some phraseology notes under Codes 8391 and 8387.
- 5. The TDI chief clerk has had copies of the full text of the filing, amendment, and related exhibits since the filing date.
- 6. The filing, amended filing, and all related exhibits are incorporated by reference into this order.
- 7. On May 23, 2018, TDI published notice of the filing on its website at www.tdi.texas.gov/rules/2018/nccimanual.html and distributed notice of the filing to electronic news subscribers.
- 8. The comment period closed on June 25, 2018, and TDI did not receive any comments or hearing requests.
- 9. The changes in *Item B-1436(FD)* apply to new and renewal workers' compensation policies effective on and after October 1, 2018.
- 10. The changes in *Item B-1436(RD)* apply to new and renewal workers' compensation policies effective on and after July 1, 2019.

#### **Conclusions of Law**

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- 1. TDI has jurisdiction over this matter under Insurance Code Article 5.96 and §\$2051.002, 2051.201, 2052.002, 2053.002, 2053.011, 2053.051, 2053.053, and 36.001.
- 2. Commissioner's Order No. 3142, dated March 21, 2014, established a procedure for the Commissioner to consider changes to NCCI's manuals:
  - a) NCCI makes a filing;
  - b) TDI publishes notice of the filing on the TDI website and distributes notice of the filing to subscribers to TDI's electronic news, with at least a 30-day period for interested persons to submit comments or request a hearing; and
  - c) The Commissioner issues an order approving the filing, approving the filing with changes, or rejecting the filing.
- 3. TDI gave proper and timely notice in compliance with Commissioner's Order No. 3142.
- 4. The Administrative Procedure Act does not apply to Commissioner's actions taken under Article 5.96.
- 5. The amendments to the NCCI manual are reasonable and consistent with Texas workers' compensation statutes and rules.
- 6. Applying the changes in *Item B-1436(FD)* to new and renewal workers' compensation policies effective on and after October 1, 2018, is reasonable.
- 7. Applying the changes in *Item B-1436(RD)*, as amended, to new and renewal workers' compensation policies effective on and after July 1, 2019, is reasonable.

TDI approves NCCI's filing, *Item B-1436(FD)*—*Revisions to Basic Manual Classifications and Appendix E - Classifications by Hazard Group Domestic Classifications*, as amended, for new and renewal workers' compensation policies effective on and after October 1, 2018.

TDI approves NCCI's filing, *Item B-1436(RD)*— *Revisions to Basic Manual Classifications and Appendix E - Classifications by Hazard Group Domestic Classifications*, as amended, for new and renewal workers' compensation policies effective on and after July 1, 2019.
