National Council on Compensation Insurance Item B-1436

Description:

• The National Council on Compensation Insurance (NCCI) filed *Items B-1436(FD)* and *B-1436(RD)* – *Revisions to Basic Manual Classifications and Appendix E - Classifications* by *Hazard Group. Items B-1436(FD)* and *B-1436(RD)* are national filings.

ITEM B-1436(FD)

- For Texas, *Item B-1436(FD)* proposes to:
 - o Reformat the following special classifications for improved online search results:
 - Building Raising or Moving (Codes 5022, 5057, 5213, 5403);
 - Farm (Codes 0005, 0008, 0011, 0016, 0035, 0037, 0079, 0083, 0113);
 - Wrecking or Demolition—Not Marine (Codes 5022, 5057, 5213, 5403, 6003); and
 - Eliminate the state special Farm note because it is properly included in the Texas exception to NCCI's Basic Manual for Workers Compensation and Employers
 Liability Insurance (Basic Manual) Rule 1-D-3-e—Farm Operations.

Requested Effective Date for *Item B-1436(FD)*:

• The filing proposes that the changes in *Item B-1436(FD)* apply to new and renewal workers' compensation policies effective on and after October 1, 2018.

ITEM B-1436(RD)

- For Texas, Item B-1436(RD) proposes to clarify the classification treatment for:
 - Retirement living centers and nursing homes by assigning healthcare employees of all types of operations to one classification and assigning all other employees to another classification;
 - Limousine and taxicab companies to indicate that garage employees be separately rated to Code 8385:

- Digital photography operations by updating phraseologies to address photo developing and printing including digital media and establishing a new Code 8015 for document scanning and quick printing operations;
- Manufacture, service, or repair, and the piloting of an unmanned aircraft system or drone aircraft by establishing new Code 8720 for employers piloting drone aircraft of less than 55 pounds for other businesses; and
- Automobile body repair and automobile repair shops by revising some phraseology notes under Codes 8391 and 8387.

Requested Effective Date for *Item B-1436(RD)*:

• The filing proposes that the changes in *Item B-1436(RD)* apply to new and renewal workers' compensation policies effective on and after July 1, 2019.

• Basic Manual for Workers Compensation and Employers Liability Insurance.
