Important notes

- FDID numbers are required to submit information to the National Fire Incident Reporting System (NFIRS) database.
 - If you have questions about FDID numbers, please email <u>TEXFIRS@tdi.texas.gov</u>.
 - FDID numbers consist of two letters and three numbers.
 - The first number is assigned under the county using the general population protected by the fire department.
 - The last two numbers are the next sequential numbers available for that county.
- You will receive an email response regarding your FDID number assignment.
