FINAL ACCOUNTING AND APPLICATION TO TERMINATE RECEIVERSHIP AND DISCHARGE RECEIVER AND SPECIAL DEPUTY RECEIVER

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF THIS COURT

JO ANN HOWARD & ASSOCIATES, P.C., Special Deputy Receiver of Alicot Insurance Company (the "SDR" and "Alicot" respectively), files this *Final Accounting and Application to Terminate Receivership and Discharge Receiver and Special Deputy Receiver* (the "Application").

I. INTRODUCTION

On April 17, 2018, this Court entered its *Order Granting Application to Report of Claims and Make Final Distribution* ("Final Distribution Order"). The SDR has completed the distribution of assets in accordance with the Final Distribution Order and submits its final accounting. The SDR requests that the Court terminate this receivership proceeding, and discharge the Texas Commissioner of Insurance ("Commissioner") as Receiver of Alicot, and JO ANN HOWARD & ASSOCIATES, P.C., as the SDR of Alicot.

II. AUTHORITY

2.1 The SDR is authorized to file this Application pursuant to Chapter 443 of the Texas Insurance Code (the "Code"), specifically § 443.352. Under § 443.154(a) of the Code, the SDR has all of the Receiver's powers, except as limited by the Receiver.

¹ All statutory references herein are to the Texas Insurance Code, unless otherwise indicated.

2.2 The subject matter of this Application is referred to the Master appointed in this proceeding in accordance with the *Order of Reference to Master* entered on September 24, 2015.

III. FINAL FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

3.1 The Balance Sheet, attached as Exhibits 1 A and 1 B, and the Sources and Uses of Cash Statement, attached as Exhibit 2, reflect the financial condition of the estate as of July 31, 2018.

IV. EXPENSES

4.1 The Final Distribution Order approved an Expense Reserve of \$24,040 for the payment of estimated expenses from March 1, 2018 through the termination of the receivership. As the actual fees of the SDR and subcontractors were \$24,540, there were no funds remaining after the payment of \$24,040. Attached as "Exhibit 3" is the Final Statement Expenses submitted pursuant to § 443.015 of the Code.

V. DISTRIBUTIONS

5.1 The SDR paid one-hundred percent (100%) of the Class 2 claim approved in the Final Distribution Order. All funds remaining after the payment of expenses and the Class 2 claim were disbursed to the Liquidator of Centennial Insurance Company ("Centennial Liquidator"), the sole stockholder of Alicot, as a Class 11 distribution.

VI. UNCLAIMED FUNDS

6.1 There were no unclaimed funds.

VII. FEDERAL INCOME TAX RETURNS

7.1 The SDR filed the final federal income tax return for the year 2018 before the filing of the Application. No income taxes are owed by the estate.

VIII. TRANFERS

8.1 The Final Distribution Order authorized the SDR to transfer all unknown assets of Alicot to the Commissioner. There are no known unliquidated assets. If funds are collected from any such assets, the Commissioner will distribute them to the Centennial Liquidator or any successor. If any such funds cannot be distributed to the Centennial Liquidator or any successor, the SDR requests that this Court authorize the Commissioner to deposit any such funds in an account under § 443.304 of the Code.

IX. RECORDS

9.1 All records of Alicot have been transferred to the Commissioner. In accordance with the Final Distribution Order, the Commissioner is authorized to dispose of any or all records transferred at his discretion.

X. CERTIFICATION OF ACTIVITIES

10.1 The SDR certifies that all activities necessary to conclude this proceeding have been performed along with the final accounting of all funds in the estate.

XI. TERMINATION AND DISCHARGE

11.1 The SDR requests that this Court issue an order terminating this delinquency proceeding and discharging the Receiver and SDR.

XII. OFFER OF PROOF

12.1 This Application is verified by the affidavit and certification pursuant to Tex. Ins. Code § 443.017(b) of the Code by Jo Ann Howard, President of Jo Ann Howard & Associates, P.C., solely in its capacity as Special Deputy Receiver of Alicot Insurance Company.

XIII. NOTICE

13.1 In accordance with § 443.007(d) and the *Order of Reference*, the SDR served this Application at least 14 days before the submission date of this Application on (i) parties that filed an appearance in this proceeding and (ii) other parties as determined by the SDR as shown on the Certificate of Service.

PRAYER

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, Jo Ann Howard & Associates, P.C., Special Deputy Receiver of Alicot Insurance Company, respectfully prays that this Court enter an Order:

- 1. Granting the Application;
- 2. Approving the Final Statement of Expenses;
- 3. Approving the Assignment to the Commissioner;
- 4. Authorizing the Commissioner to distribute any funds recovered from the unknown assets assigned to the Commissioner to the Centennial Liquidator or any successor, or, if they cannot be distributed to the Centennial Liquidator or any successor, deposit any such funds in an account under § 443.304 of the Code;
- 5. Discharging the Receiver and SDR;
- 6. Terminating this delinquency proceeding; and
- 7. Granting such further relief to which the SDR or Receiver may be entitled.

- 5. Please note that if an objection is not filed as described in the Notice of Submission, the Master may consider the Application without a hearing.
- 6. Failure to file timely a written objection before the Special Master constitutes a waiver of the right to object to the Special Master's recommendation to the District Court.
