General remarks and official action taken:

This is a default order taken against Geoffrey Wayne Leininger ("Respondent") because he: failed to notify the department of regulatory actions taken against him in the states of Washington, Louisiana, and California; engaged in fraudulent and dishonest acts; failed to notify the department of the change in his mailing address; failed to respond to an inquiry; and, he is not actively engaged in soliciting or writing insurance in Texas. Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Hearing filed by the department. This order revokes Respondents' license.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

Failure to Respond to Notice of Hearing

- On February 7, 2020, the department filed a Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit
 A, and an Original Petition, attached as Exhibit B, with the State Office of
 Administrative Hearings.
- 2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.

4. Respondent failed to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing within 20 days of the date the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were mailed.

- 2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally pursuant to TEX. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; TEX. INS. CODE § 82.055; and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
- 3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing pursuant to Tex. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054, and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
- 4. Based on Respondent's failure to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default pursuant to 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
- The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true pursuant to 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.89.

ORIGINAL PETITION

The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to take disciplinary action against Geoffrey Wayne Leininger. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

Jurisdiction

The commissioner of insurance has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, 4051.051, 4051.401, 4054.051; TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051-2001.178; and TEX. OCC. CODE §§ 53.021-53.023.

Factual Allegations

Licensure

- Geoffrey Wayne Leininger ("Leininger"), individual identification no. 1191684, was issued a general lines agent license with a life, accident, and health qualification, by the department on July 23, 2013.
- 2. The department issued a personal lines property and casualty agent license to Leininger on March 30, 2016.
- On January 31, 2020, Leininger's general lines agent license and personal lines property and casualty agent license expired. However, under TEX. INS. CODE § 4003.007, Leininger may still attempt to renew his licenses.

Washington Revocation for Binding Coverage Without Knowledge or Consent

- On July 11, 2018, the State of Washington Office of the Insurance Commissioner ("Washington Insurance Commissioner") entered an order revoking Leininger's license ("Order") after Leininger's potential customer complained (the "Complainant").
- The Order advised Leininger that a demand for hearing must be made in writing within ninety (90) days after the Order was mailed to Leininger. Leininger did not demand such a hearing.
- The Order found the following:
 - a. The Complainant, a Washington resident, requested quotes from various insurers and received a quote from Leininger, with Liberty Mutual, on December 17, 2017, for home, auto, and umbrella policies. The Complainant was clear during her call with Leininger that she was only seeking a quote.
 - b. On Monday, December 18, 2019, the Complainant told Leininger over the phone that she was not interested in purchasing the policy, but Leininger bound her to the policy soon after this phone call. The Complainant's mortgage escrow account was charged a premium payment for such policy. The Complainant filed a complaint with the Washington Insurance Commissioner.
 - c. The Complainant did not sign an application for the policy to which Leininger bound her.
 - d. On December 26, 2017, the Complainant called Liberty Mutual to cancel the policy. The Complainant's phone call prompted an internal investigation by Liberty Mutual of Leininger. Liberty Mutual discovered two other similar situations where customers requested cancellation of homeowners policies to which Leininger bound them.
 - e. On February 7, 2018, Leininger voluntarily resigned from Liberty Mutual before Liberty Mutual could interview him about the incident.

> f. The Complainant informed the Washington Insurance Commissioner that Liberty Mutual reimbursed the Complainant for the premium paid through her mortgage escrow account.

Disciplinary Actions in Louisiana and California

- On February 18, 2019, the State of Louisiana issued an order revoking Leininger's individual producer license for failing to report administrative action in the State of Washington and failing to provide documentation as requested.
- 8. On June 13, 2019, the State of California issued an order revoking Leininger's non-resident license to act as a personal lines broker-agent for failing to report administrative action in the States of Washington and Louisiana, and for placing policies for insurance without an individual's and other consumer's knowledge or consent.
- Leininger did not notify the department of the administrative actions or license revocations in the States of Washington, Louisiana, or California.
- Leininger did not notify the National Insurance Producer Registry ("NIPR") of the administrative actions or his license revocations in the States of Washington, Louisiana, or California.
- As of the date of this notice of hearing, Leininger has not provided the department with a copy of the order or applicable judgment from the States of Washington, Louisiana, or California.

Failure to Notify Department of Change in Mailing Address

- During an April 12, 2019 phone conversation with department staff, Leininger provided information indicating that his mailing address of record with the department was no longer current. Leininger was instructed to update his mailing address.
- As of September 3, 2019, Leininger failed to update his mailing address of record with the department.

- 14. On September 3, 2019, Leininger was instructed in a phone call with a department staff that his mailing address must be updated. Leininger agreed to update it.
- 15. On September 9, 2019, Leininger's mailing address had still not been updated. The department sent him an email instructing him again to update his mailing address.

Failure to Respond to an Inquiry

- 16. On September 27, 2019, the department sent an inquiry to Leininger and informed him that he must respond not later than 15 days after receipt of the inquiry.
- Although the inquiry was sent to Leininger via email, first class mail, and certified mail, return receipt requested, Leininger did not respond to the department's inquiry.

Not Actively Engaged in Soliciting or Writing Insurance

- 18. During a phone call on September 3, 2019, Leininger informed department staff that he had not engaged in the business of insurance for a few months.
- 19. At that time and presently, Leininger has only one active appointment with Federal Insurance Company.

Legal Allegations

- Leininger failed to notify the department on a monthly basis of an administrative action taken against him by a financial or insurance regulator of this state, another state, or the United States, as contemplated by Tex. Ins. Code § 4001.252(a)(3).
- Leininger has engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices, as contemplated by TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(5).
- 3. Leininger failed to notify the department on a monthly basis of a change to Leininger's mailing address, as contemplated by Tex. INS. CODE § 4001.252(a)(1).
- 4. Leininger failed to respond to the department's inquiry in writing not later than the 15th day after the date of the inquiry, as contemplated by Tex. Ins. Code § 38.001.

5. Leininger was not actively engaged in soliciting or writing insurance for the public generally, as contemplated by TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(10).

Relief Sought

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, the department asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

- 1. revoking Leininger's licenses; and
- 2. any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law.
