**General remarks and official action taken:**

The subject of this default order is whether a general lines agent license with a life, accident, and health qualification should be issued to Paul Dean Jamison (Respondent). Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Hearing filed by the Texas Department of Insurance. This order denies Respondent's license application.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

**Findings of Fact**

Failure to Respond to Notice of Hearing

1. On March 10, 2021, the department filed a Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit A, and an Original Petition, attached as Exhibit B, with the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.
3. The department sent the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department, [REDACTED]

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Worth, Texas 76140. The Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were also sent by electronic mail.

4. Respondent failed to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing within 20 days of the date the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were mailed.

## Conclusions of Law

1. The commissioner has jurisdiction pursuant to Texas law, including TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4001.102, 4001.105, 4005.101-4005.105, and 4054.051; TEX. OCC. CODE §§ 53.021-53.023; 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502; and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally pursuant to TEX. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; TEX. INS. CODE § 82.055; and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing pursuant to TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054, and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
4. Based on Respondent's failure to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default pursuant to 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
5. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true pursuant to 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.89.

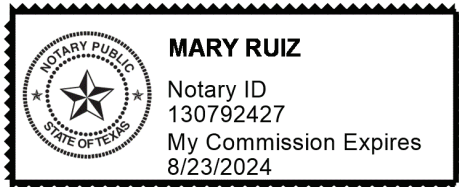

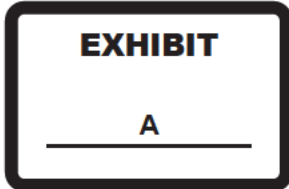
The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to deny your license application. This Notice of Hearing and the Original Petition, which is attached and incorporated for all purposes, states the allegations against you and the relief sought by the Department.

A public hearing will be held before an Administrative Law Judge on **Wednesday, May 26, 2021, at 9:00 a.m.** The hearing will take place via videoconference using a videoconference platform controlled by the State Office of Administrative Hearings, unless otherwise ordered to proceed in another manner by the Administrative Law Judge.

The hearing shall be conducted pursuant to TEX. GOV'T CODE, ch. 2001 and 1 TEX. ADMIN. CODE, ch. 155. Unless otherwise directed by the Administrative Law Judge, the hearing shall continue from day to day in the offices of the State Office of Administrative Hearings until concluded. You have the right to appear at this hearing and to be represented by an attorney.

**Parties that are not represented by an attorney may obtain information regarding contested case hearings on the public website of the State Office of Administrative Hearings at [www.soah.texas.gov](http://www.soah.texas.gov), or in printed format upon request to SOAH.**

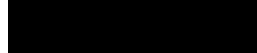

**ORIGINAL PETITION**

The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to deny Paul Dean Jamison’s license application. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

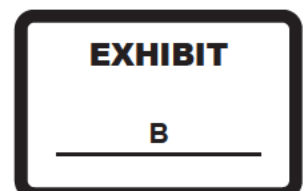
**Jurisdiction**

The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4054.051, and TEX. GOV’T CODE §§ 2001.051-2001.178.

**Factual Allegations**

License Application

1. On September 11, 2019, Paul Dean Jamison (Jamison) applied for a general lines agent license with a life, accident, and health qualification to be issued by the Texas Department of Insurance (the department).
2. On October 31, 2019, the department proposed to deny Jamison’s application based on his criminal history. Jamison appealed that decision and made a written request for a hearing on November 21, 2019.



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### Criminal History

3. On June 24, 2016, Jamison was convicted of a 3rd degree felony offense of "Online Solicit of a Minor" in cause no. 1433235D, in the [REDACTED] Tarrant County, Texas. The court convicted Jamison of the offense and sentenced him to four years confinement and court costs.
4. Also, on June 24, 2016, Jamison pleaded guilty to a 3rd degree felony offense of "sexual assault of a child-solicit minor" in cause no. 1433131D, in the [REDACTED] Tarrant County, Texas. The court placed Jamison on deferred adjudication, with probation for a period of 10 years, and ordered him to pay court costs.
5. As of the date of Jamison's application for licensure and this Original Petition, Jamison is still on community supervision. Jamison is not set to be released from community supervision until 2026.
6. Jamison is a registered sex offender.

### **Legal Allegations**

1. Jamison has committed an act for which a license may be denied pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b) because he has been convicted of a felony, as contemplated by TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(8).
2. Jamison committed an offense that the department considers to be of such serious nature that it is of prime importance in determining fitness for licensure or authorization, as contemplated by 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(e).
3. Jamison committed a felony involving moral turpitude, as contemplated by 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(e)(3).
4. Jamison committed a felony involving assault, as contemplated by 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(e)(4)(B).
5. Jamison has been convicted of an offense listed in Article 42A.054 of the Code of Criminal Procedure as contemplated by TEX. OCC. CODE § 53.021(a)(2).

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6. Pursuant to TEX. OCC. CODE § 53.021(d), the commissioner may deny Jamison's application and consider him to have been convicted of sexual assault of a child-solicit minor because:
  - a. he has not completed the period of supervision, pursuant to TEX. OCC. CODE § 53.021(d)(1)(B)(i); and
  - b. pursuant to TEX. OCC. CODE § 53.021(d)(2), the department determined:
    - i. Jamison continues to pose a continued threat to public safety; or
    - ii. employment of Jamison in the licensed occupation will create a situation in which he has the opportunity to repeat the prohibit conduct.
7. Department guidelines, 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(c)-(e), emphasize that the department:
  - a. considers it very important that applicants be honest, trustworthy, and reliable;
  - b. may refuse to issue an original license if the department determines that the applicant has committed a felony or misdemeanor, or has engaged in fraudulent or dishonest activity that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation;
  - c. considers any felony involving moral turpitude to be of such a serious nature that it is of prime importance when determining fitness for licensure, pursuant to TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(e)(3);
  - d. considers any felony assault to be of such a serious nature that it is of prime importance when determining fitness for licensure, pursuant to TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(e)(4)(B).

### **Relief Sought**

If one or more of the allegations is found to be true, the department asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

1. denying Paul Dean Jamison's license application and
2. imposing any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law.

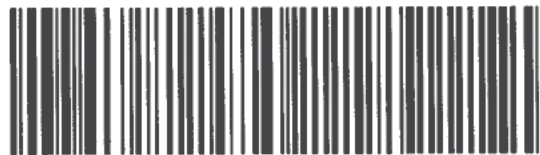

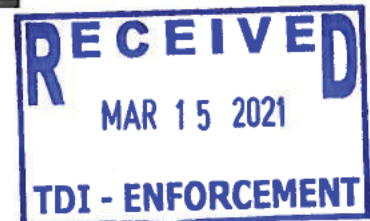

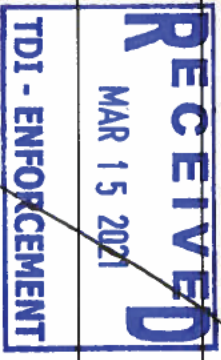
