In accord with Texas Insurance Code Section 2151.053 and the TAIPA plan of operation, the governing committee shall consist of eighteen members:

1. eight members who represent the interests of insurers;
2. five public members nominated by the Office of Public Insurance Counsel;
3. two members who are general or personal lines property and casualty agents; and
4. three alternate public members.

Terms: Public members serve two year staggered terms. Agent members serve one year terms, Alternate Agent member serves one year term, and Insurer Representatives are elected annually by association members.
