He earned his medical degree at the Oregon Health Sciences University, and completed his Family Practice residency in Merced, California. He has served as a Designated Doctor for the Division of Workers' Compensation since 2000 and has been a speaker for the designated doctor certification training course on topics including Extent of Injury, Return to Work and Non-Musculoskeletal impairment ratings.
