Re: Claim Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) Release 3.1 Implementation

The Texas Department of Insurance, Division of Workers' Compensation designated Verisk as the data collection agent for claim EDI release 3.1 data. The Verisk website is now available at <https://txdwcedi.info/>.

Insurance carriers, trading partners, and claim administrators should complete their registration no later than January 12, 2023, to ensure they will be ready to submit claim data in production by the July 26, 2023, effective date for claim EDI release 3.1.4 reporting. All organizations must complete the registration with Verisk, including organizations approved to submit claim EDI release 1.0 data for Texas.

The website has links to the Texas implementation guide, the data element and event tables, and the edit matrix on the requirements page. Texas claim EDI release 3.1.4 trading partner registration is also available on the website at <https://wcs.iso.com/tp-register/login>. Detailed registration instructions are also available to download.

Verisk will soon bill reporting insurance carriers, other than governmental entities, for the cost of data collection. We will send another notification about the billing process soon.
