Subject: Adoption of 28 TAC §133.307 MDR of Fee Disputes, Effective for disputes filed on or after June 1, 2012

The Texas Department of Insurance, Division of Workers' Compensation (TDI-DWC) has amended 28 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §133.307 related to Medical Fee Dispute Resolution. Workers' compensation system participants should become familiar with the amended rule as it contains the updated medical fee dispute resolution process, and important changes related to the appeal of a medical fee dispute decision. The amended rule is applicable to disputes received on or after June 1, 2012.
