PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

The CertainTeed New Castle XT awning window is a vinyl awning window. The vinyl awning windows evaluated in this report are individual, non-impact resistant windows. This product evaluation report is for vinyl awning windows based on the following tested construction:

Glass Construction Key:

IG-1: The window contains a sealed insulating glass unit. The sealed insulating glass unit is comprised of two double strength ($\frac{1}{8}$ ") annealed glass lites separated by a U-shaped spacer system that is embedded in sealant. The glass thickness and type used in the insulating glass unit of the tested assembly and in smaller assemblies shall comply with ASTM E 1300-04.

Glazing Method Key:

GM-1: The insulating glass unit is set from the exterior onto a bed of structural silicone sealant. Snap-on dual-durometer glazing beads secure the insulating glass unit in place.

Frame Construction: The frame members are manufactured from extruded PVC (vinyl). The frame corners are mitered and welded construction.

Sash Construction: The sash stiles and rails are constructed of extruded PVC (vinyl). The sash corners are mitered and welded construction.

Reinforcement:

System 1: Extruded aluminum reinforcement is utilized in the sash stiles and rails and in the frame sill and side jambs. The reinforcement extends the length of the members.

System 2: Extruded aluminum reinforcement is utilized in the sash stiles and rails and in the frame Head and sill. The reinforcement extends the length of the members.

Hardware:

- Roto operator with handle; One (1) required; Located on the sill.
- Hinges; Two (2) required; Located at the top of both sash stiles.
- Locks; Two (2) required; Located 6 inches up from the sill, one on each side jamb.
- Snubbers; Two (2) required; Located on the head jamb and top rail.

Product Identification: A certification program label (AAMA) will be affixed to the window. The certification program label includes the manufacturer's code name (**BUR-1**); product name: **New Castle XT Awning**; performance characteristics; the approved inspection agency (AAMA); and the applicable standard: AAMA/WDMA/CSA 101/I.S.2/A440-05.

LIMITATIONS

Design pressures:

Impact Resistance: These window assemblies do not satisfy the Texas Department of Insurance's criteria for protection from windborne debris. These window assemblies will need to be protected with an impact protective system when installed in areas where windborne debris protection is required.

Acceptance of Smaller Assemblies: Window assemblies with dimensions equal to or smaller than those specified above are acceptable within the limitations specified in this report.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

General: The window assembly shall be installed in accordance with the manufacturer's installation instructions and this evaluation report. Detailed drawings and installation instructions are available from the manufacturer.

Installation: The wood wall framing members shall be minimum Southern Yellow Pine dimension lumber. The window shall be mounted to the wood wall framing members using the nailing fin of the window with minimum No. 8 x 1 $\frac{5}{8}$ " screws. The fasteners shall be spaced approximately 2 inches from each corner and approximately 8 inches on center along the perimeter of the window. The fasteners shall be long enough to penetrate a minimum of 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches into the wall framing members. The window shall be set in a bed of silicone.

Note: The manufacturer's installation instructions shall be available on the job site during installation. All fasteners shall be corrosion resistant as specified in the International Residential Code (IRC), the International Building Code (IBC), and the Texas Revisions.
