HOUSE BILLS (HB)

- [HB 33](#) Relating to alternative methods of dispute resolution in certain disputes between the Department of Aging and Disability Services and an assisted living facility licensed by the department.
- [HB 746](#) Relating to the registration of volunteer health practitioners and the services of volunteer health practitioners during disasters.
- [HB 1376](#) Relating to advertising by certain facilities that provide emergency services.
- [HB 3152](#) Relating to the payment of and contracts with health care providers by certain entities under contract with a certified workers' compensation network.
