- [HB 21](#) Relating to authorizing patients with certain terminal illnesses to access certain investigational drugs, biological products, and devices that are in clinical trials.
- [HB 751](#) Relating to the prescription and pharmaceutical substitution of biological products; amending provisions subject to a criminal penalty.
- [HB 966](#) Relating to the creation of an optional consumer-directed health plan for certain individuals eligible to participate in the group benefits program provided under the Texas Employees Group Benefits Act and their qualified dependents.
- [HB 1038](#) Relating to premium payment assistance for insurance coverage for hemophilia medical treatment.
- [HB 1550](#) Relating to the administration of epinephrine by pharmacists.
- [HB 1841](#) Relating to the applicability of the sales and use tax to certain insurance services.
