#### **CONSENT ORDER**

TDI ENFORCEMENT FILE NO. 11362

#### General remarks and official action taken:

The commissioner of insurance considers whether disciplinary action should be taken against Cullin Smith Abstract & Title, Inc. d/b/a Security Abstract & Title Company.

#### WAIVER

Security Abstract & Title Company acknowledges that the Texas Insurance Code and other applicable law provide certain rights. Security Abstract & Title Company waives all of these rights, and any other applicable procedural rights, in consideration of the entry of this consent order.

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- Security Abstract & Title Company holds a title insurance agent license issued by TDI.
- Title agents, including Security Abstract & Title Company, are required to remit
  premium funds to underwriters no later than the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the second month
  following the month in which the premium is collected.
- 3. During a routine audit performed in May 2015, TDI identified 72 files for which Security Abstract & Title Company was delinquent in remitting the premium to

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underwriters. Security Abstract & Title Company collected the premium for these files during the months of October 2014 through January 2015.

- 4. Security Abstract & Title Company owed a total of \$10,823.21 to three underwriters: Chicago Title Insurance Company; Fidelity National Title Insurance Company; and WFG National Title Insurance Company.
- 5. Chicago Title Insurance Company, Fidelity National Title Insurance Company, and WFG National Title Insurance Company have each confirmed that Security Abstract & Title Company remitted the delinquent premium by June 25, 2015.
- 6. Security Abstract & Title Company had not issued 25 title insurance policies by May 2015 for transactions Security Abstract & Title Company closed during the months of December 2014 and January 2015.

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. The commissioner has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Tex. INS. CODE §§ 82.051 82.056, 2651.013, 2651.301, 2703.003; 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 9.1 adopting the *Texas Title Insurance Basic Manual* (Basic Manual); and Tex. Gov'T CODE §§ 2001.051 2001.178.
- 2. The commissioner has the authority to dispose of this case informally pursuant to Tex. Gov'T Code § 2001.056, Tex. Ins. Code § 82.055, and 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.47.
- 3. Security Abstract & Title Company failed to pay the premium for title insurance policies in the due and ordinary course of business in violation of Tex. Ins. Code § 2703.003.
- 4. Security Abstract & Title Company failed to remit the portion of the premium due to the title insurance company before the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the second month following the month in which the premium is collected in violation of Rate Rule R-2 of the Basic Manual.
- 5. Security Abstract & Title Company failed to furnish and provide title insurance policies to insureds within 90 days after closing the transaction in violation of Procedural Rule P-61 of the Basic Manual.

The commissioner orders Cullin Smith Abstract & Title, Inc. d/b/a Security Abstract & Title Company to pay an administrative penalty of \$5,000. The administrative penalty must be paid in full on or before 30 days from the entry date of this Order. The administrative

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penalty shall be paid by cashier's check or money order made payable to the "State of Texas" and transmitted to the Texas Department of Insurance, Attn: Enforcement Section, Division 40111, MC 9999, P.O. Box 149104, Austin, Texas 78714-9104.


