Detailed Claim Information (DCI)

The *Call for Texas Detailed Claim Information (DCI)* collects data on workers' compensation claims of more than \$5,000. The information is used for research and medical cost containment purposes by the Texas Workers' Compensation Commission and the Research and Oversight Council on Workers' Compensation Insurance.

Pursuant to *TIC* Art. 5.58(c) all insurers or other entities authorized to write workers' compensation insurance in Texas are required to file. The first report is due six (6) months after the injury is reported to insurer if incurred losses are \$5,000 or more. Subsequent reports are to be filed annually from 6 month valuation date until the claim is closed, no longer has indemnity or medical losses to report, or reaches the ninth reporting level, whichever comes first.
