

## Published Reports

The [Texas Liability Insurance Closed Claim Annual Report](#) is developed from data gathered from companies reporting liability insurance claim settlements via Quarterly Closed Claim Reports, the Annual Aggregate Report, and Closed Claim Reconciliation Forms. The annual report provides data concerning the liability insurance claim settlement process and its relationship with the civil justice system in Texas. In accordance with SB 784, 84<sup>th</sup> Regular Session, TDI will discontinue collecting this data beginning with claims closed in calendar year 2016.

Data collected from the Disallowed Expense Report captures "disallowed" expenses on a countrywide basis and is used to produce the [General Expense Information: 110% of Industry Mean Report](#), which is published for use by all companies writing lines of insurance subject to Texas Insurance Code Chapter 2251.

The [Annual Legislative Report on Market Conditions](#) data is gathered from the call for Annual Experience and the call for Annual Experience-Workers' Compensation Deductible Plans. The report provides information about market share and losses, and to meet legislative requirements. (This report was formerly known as the *Quarterly Legislative Report on Market Conditions*. It changed to an annual report in 2016.)

The [Texas Title Insurance Agent Experience Report Compilation](#) and the [State of Texas Title Insurance Industry Experience Report Compilation](#) provide information on annual income and expenses in the title industry.

Data collected from unit statistical reports are used to produce the [Workers' Compensation Relativities Study](#). Data collected from the Texas Workers' Compensation Financial call is used to produce the [Call for Workers' Compensation Experience Reports](#).

Additional reports include the [Texas Property and Casualty Insurance Experience by Coverage and Carriers](#) (exhibit of premiums and losses) and the [Insurance Expense Exhibit \(IEE\)](#), which are compilations of data downloaded from the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC).
