Filing Smart

Unit Statistical Information (Unit Stat)

Unit Statistical Data (Unit Stat) is collected and maintained for every workers' compensation policy written in Texas. The data is used in developing job classification relativities, expected loss rates and ratios for use by the industry. The following three reports are produced from the unit stat data: (1) *Texas Schedule Z Report*; (2) *Year End Reports*; and (3) *Job Classification Relativities*. Each report is based on the effective year of the policy.

Pursuant to *TIC* Art. 5.58, all insurers or other entities licensed to and currently writing workers' compensation in Texas are required to file the first report 18 months after the effective date of the policy. For policies with losses, subsequent reports must be filed up through the 5th reporting level or until all claims are closed, whichever comes first.
