

Other selection criteria include the FDIDs to include, the date range, data version, incident validity and release status. For each reported incident, the FDID, FDID state, incident date, incident number, exposure number, assisted/ing FDID, assisted/ing FDID state, and assisted/ing incident number. The report ends with the total number of mutual aid incidents.
