TEXAS AMUSEMENT RIDE SAFETY INSPECTION AND INSURANCE ACT
DAILY INSPECTION RECORD

KNOW THE LOCATION OF THE FIRST AID STATION, FIRE EXTINGUISHER AND PROPER EMERGENCY PROCEDURES, AND INCIDENT, NO MATTER HOW SMALL, MUST BE REPORTED TO THE OFFICE AT ONCE.

The Daily Inspection Record must be maintained for one year at the location where the ride is operated and be available for inspection by a municipal, county or state law enforcement official.

It will be the responsibility of the foreman of each device to insure cleanliness and proper maintenance of the device and related equipment. Report any problems to the Maintenance Department or ride superintendent.
