Supplement to Request for Qualifications for Special Deputy Receiver

This Supplement contains any clarifications, additional information, and/or answers to questions posed to date regarding the RFP.

I. Supplemental Information

A. Question and Answers

1. **Question:** If an entity or individual was qualified via a previous RFQ, do they need to submit an application to this RFQ (RFQ-SDR-2010-1)?

Response: Yes, all entities and individuals who wish to be eligible to submit a bid on any future RFPs for SDR services must submit an application and be qualified via RFQ-SDR-2010-1.

2. **Question:** My Company "ABC" Inc. has very recently been purchased 100% by "XYZ" Ltd (a UK registered company) and has been renamed "XYZ" USA Inc. Would you please advise whether I should therefore apply for an SDR in the name of "XYZ" USA Inc. and/or "XYZ" Limited?

Response: Apply in the name of the entity or individual that would be bidding to serve as the SDR. Every entity that wants the option to bid as an SDR must apply. Also, refer to Section 5.2 (Disclosure of Ownership).

3. **Question:** Is there a deadline to submit the RFQ?

Response: No, there is no deadline to submit the RFQ. However, your Application must have been processed and designated as eligible in order for you to bid on any SDR opportunities that may arise. We will begin reviewing Applications on or around September 1, 2010, and anticipate processing to take 30 to 60 days after submission.

4. **Question:** In Section 5.2 (Disclosure of Ownership), what type of biographical information is needed for persons with 10% or more ownership interests? Is detailed curriculum vitae (resume) sufficient or is more disclosure required?

Response: A detailed curriculum vitae or resume is sufficient.

5. **Question:** I was wondering whether I need to submit any documents right now (I think there was some signed form we used to have to send you).

Response: Please complete either; Attachment 1A- Application Form for Legal Entities Or Attachment 1B- Application Form for Individuals. No additional documents; such as, a confidentiality agreement, are required at this time.

6. **Question:** As a single member LLC, do I submit the individual or corporate form?

Response: Please see the response to Question 2. However, an "LLC" is a legal entity and should be qualified via Attachment 1A- Application Form for Legal Entities.
