Requestor's Position Summary: "The carrier has received the attached bill and has not processed according to Texas Labor Code 408.027."

Amount in Dispute: \$387.66

Respondent's Position Summary: "Memorial's submission of 9/16/19 falsely claims it received no response from the Carrier, noting its Request for Reconsideration was received by the Carrier on 8/06/19. The Carrier did issue its EOB on 8/19/19."

FINDINGS AND DECISION

This medical fee dispute is decided pursuant to Texas Labor Code §413.031 and applicable rules of the Texas Department of Insurance, Division of Workers' Compensation (DWC).

Background

- 1. 28 Texas Administrative Code §133.307 sets out the procedures for resolving medical fee disputes.
2. 28 Texas Administrative Code §134.503 sets out the fee guidelines for pharmaceutical services.

Issues

Is Memorial Compounding Rx (Memorial) entitled to reimbursement of the drugs in question?

Findings

Memorial wants reimbursement for drugs dispensed on June 11, 2019. Memorial argued that it had not gotten a response from the insurance carrier for its bills.

Flahive, Ogden & Latson submitted an explanation of benefits (EOB), dated August 19, 2019. This EOB is labeled as a reconsideration and shows a total payment of \$0.00, citing denial of additional money based on fee guidelines.

The DWC requested an initial EOB on November 14, 2019. Flahive, Ogden & Latson responded stating that, "the reconsideration is the only EOB" the insurance carrier had.

Based on the available information, the DWC finds that Memorial is entitled to reimbursement for the drugs in question. The reimbursement considered in this dispute is calculated as follows¹:

- Meloxicam 15 mg tablets: $(4.845 \times 36 \times 1.25) + \$4.00 = \$222.03$
- Cyclobenzaprine 10 mg tablets: $(1.0915 \times 90 \times 1.25) + \$4.00 = \$126.79$

The total reimbursement is \$348.82. This amount is recommended.

Conclusion

For the reasons stated above, the DWC finds that the requestor has established that additional reimbursement is due. As a result, the amount ordered is \$348.82.

ORDER

Based on the submitted information, pursuant to Texas Labor Code Section 413.031 and 413.019 (if applicable), the DWC has determined the requestor is entitled to additional reimbursement for the disputed services. The DWC hereby ORDERS the respondent to remit to the requestor \$348.82, plus applicable accrued interest per 28 Texas Administrative Code §134.130, due within 30 days of receipt of this order.

YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

Either party to this medical fee dispute has a right to seek review of this decision in accordance with Rule §133.307, effective May 31, 2012, *37 Texas Register 3833*, **applicable to disputes filed on or after June 1, 2012.**

A party seeking review must submit a **Request to Schedule a Benefit Review Conference to Appeal a Medical Fee Dispute Decision** (form **DWC045M**) in accordance with the instructions on the form. The request must be received by the DWC within **twenty** days of your receipt of this decision. The request may be faxed, mailed or personally delivered to the DWC using the contact information listed on the form or to the field office handling the claim.

The party seeking review of the MFDR decision shall deliver a copy of the request to all other parties involved in the dispute at the same time the request is filed. **Please include a copy of the *Medical Fee Dispute Resolution Findings and Decision*** together with any other required information specified in 28 Texas Administrative Code §141.1(d).
