## **Findings and Decision**

### <u>Authority</u>

This medical fee dispute is decided according to Texas Labor Code §413.031 and applicable rules of the Texas Department of Insurance, Division of Workers' Compensation (DWC).

#### Statutes and Rules

- 1. 28 TAC §133.307 sets out the procedures for resolving medical fee disputes.
- 2. 28 TAC §134.503 sets out the fee guidelines for oral medications.

#### **Denial Reasons**

- 1. 877 Reimbursement is based on the contracted amount.
- 2. 45 Charge exceeds fee schedule/maximum allowable or contracted/legislated fee arrangement.

#### Issues

1. What rule(s) apply to disputed services?

### **Findings**

- 1. The requestor is seeking reimbursement for oral medication dispensed in January 2021.
  - The insurance company provided evidence of a payment of \$138.06 via electronic fund transfer 94077531, The service in dispute will be reviewed per applicable fee guideline.
  - DWC Rule 28 Texas Administrative Code §134.503 (c) states the insurance carrier shall reimburse the health care provider or pharmacy processing agent for prescription drugs the lesser of the fee established by the following formulas based on the average wholesale price (AWP) as reported by a nationally recognized pharmaceutical price guide or other publication of pharmaceutical pricing data in effect on the day the prescription drug is dispensed:
    - Generic drugs: ((AWP per unit) x (number of units) x 1.25) + \$4.00 dispensing fee per prescription = reimbursement amount;
    - Brand name drugs: ((AWP per unit) x (number of units) x 1.09) + \$4.00 dispensing fee per prescription = reimbursement amount;

The total reimbursement is \$141.46. The insurance carrier paid \$138.06. The balance of \$3.40 is recommended.

#### Conclusion

The outcome of this medical fee dispute is based on the evidence presented by the requestor and the respondent at the time of adjudication. Though all evidence may not have been discussed, it was considered.

DWC finds the requester has established that additional reimbursement is due.

#### **Order**

Under Texas Labor Code §§413.031 and 413.019, DWC has determined the requestor is entitled to additional reimbursement for the disputed services. It is ordered that State Farm Fire & Casualty must remit to Memorial Compounding Pharmacy \$3.40 plus applicable accrued interest within 30 days of receiving this order in accordance with 28 TAC §134.130.
