NOTICE OF INDEPENDENT REVIEW DECISION

January 3, 2003

Re: IRO Case # M2-03-0396

Texas Worker's Compensation Commission:

___ has been certified as an independent review organization (IRO) and has been authorized to perform independent reviews of medical necessity for the Texas Worker's Compensation Commission (TWCC). Texas HB. 2600, Rule133.308 effective January 1, 2002, allows a claimant or provider who has received an adverse medical necessity determination from a carrier's internal process, to request an independent review by an IRO.

In accordance with the requirement that TWCC assign cases to certified IROs, TWCC assigned this case to ___ for an independent review. ___ has performed an independent review of the proposed care to determine if the adverse determination was appropriate. For that purpose, ___ received relevant medical records, any documents obtained from parties in making the adverse determination, and any other documents and/or written information submitted in support of the appeal.

The case was reviewed by a physician who is Board Certified in Neurological Surgery. He or she has signed a certification statement attesting that no known conflicts of interest exist between him or her and any of the treating physicians or providers, or any of the physicians or providers who reviewed the case for a determination prior to referral to ___ for independent review. In addition, the certification statement further attests that the review was performed without bias for or against the carrier, medical provider, or any other party to this case.

The determination of the ___ reviewer who reviewed this case, based on the medical records provided, is as follows:

History

The patient is a 40-year-old male who on ___ developed low back pain after pushing a garbage disposal. Physical therapy and medications did not result in improvement. An MRI on 7/17/98 showed a questionable right-sided disk rupture at L5-S1 with possible right-sided nerve root compression. The patient also had right lower extremity pain. A repeat MRI on 11/18/99 showed a questionable left-sided L5-S1 disk problem despite the patient's primary right-sided symptoms. A CT scan 10/21/99 showed only chronic abnormalities. As of 6/27/02 the patient's back and leg pain continued despite significant weight loss of 50-60 pounds.

Requested Service

Repeat MRI of the Lumbar spine

Decision

I disagree with the carrier's decision to deny the requested MRI.

Rationale

The patient continues to have symptoms of changes in the lumbar spine that might be correctable. According to the records provided for this review, it has been three years since the last MRI. During that time changes could have occurred that might be correctable.

This medical necessity decision by an Independent Review Organization is deemed to be a Commission decision and order.

YOUR RIGHT TO REQUEST A HEARING

Either party to this medical dispute may disagree with all or part of the decision and has a right to request a hearing.

If disputing a spinal surgery prospective decision, a request for a hearing must be in writing, and it must be received by the TWCC Chief Clerk of Proceedings within **10** (ten) days of your receipt of this decision (28 Tex. Admin. Code 142.5(c)).

If disputing other prospective medical necessity (preauthorization) decisions, a request for a hearing must be in writing, and it must be received by the TWCC Chief Clerk of Proceedings within **20** (twenty) days of your receipt of this decision (28 Tex. Admin. Code 148.3).

This decision is deemed received by you 5 (five) days after it was mailed (28 Tex. Admin. Code 102.4(h) or 102.5(d)). A request for a hearing should be sent to:

The party appealing this decision shall deliver a copy of its written request for a hearing to all other parties involved in the dispute (Commission Rule 133.308(t)(2)).
