The Texas Department of Insurance is considering changes to update the Texas Statistical Plan for Residential Risks. TDI seeks public input to changes to the statistical plan under consideration including those that would: (1) eliminate obsolete references and coding in the statistical plan; (2) require additional coding to reflect changes in the residential property market; (3) eliminate the requirement that companies report certain individual optional credits and instead require reporting about certain rating variables; and (4) make nonsubstantive changes to reflect current practice and clarify how companies should report data in certain circumstances.
