

**Draft of Rules Relating to  
Title 28 Texas Administrative Code  
Chapter 5, Subchapter L, Reporting Requirements for Liability Insurance under Insurance  
Code, Article 1.24a and Article 1.24b; §19.1714, Regulatory Requirements Subsequent to  
Certification or Registration; and  
§19.2014, Regulatory Requirements Subsequent to Certification or Registration**

Comments due by October 30, 2015

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The Texas Department of Insurance has prepared a working draft of repeals and amendments to update sections of 28 TAC Chapters 5 and 19. The purpose of this working draft is to obtain public and stakeholder input regarding the proposed changes to the sections to conform them to statutory changes made by SB 784, 84th Legislature, Regular Session (2015).

The intention of the working draft is to eliminate the

- requirement for data collection on closed claims and the compilation of that report; and
- utilization review agents' summary reports of all complaints, adverse determinations, and appeals of adverse determinations.

TDI invites your input on the working draft repeals and amendments, and welcomes your comments on any new costs that you anticipate could result from them.

This is not a formal publication for rulemaking.
