

Informal Working Draft and Request for Informal Comments on Loss Control Rule
Texas Administrative Code, Title 28, Chapter 5, new Subchapter L

Posting date: November 22, 2016
Comments due: December 6, 2016

The Texas Department of Insurance has prepared an informal working draft of a rule on loss control information and services. The informal working draft proposes to repeal the existing loss control rules, located in 28 TAC Chapter 5, Divisions 4, 7, and 8; and replace them with updated rules in new 28 TAC Chapter 5, Subchapter L.

Updating obsolete references, enumerating the requirements instead of adopting them by reference, and consolidating and clarifying the requirements for loss control information and services will help ensure that the rules are clear, current, and accurate; and that they rely on the correct statutes to support them. Using the inspections to verify insurers' determinations of their loss control representatives' qualifications, instead of requiring loss control representatives to submit applications to TDI, will eliminate the need for an obsolete list and make the process more efficient.

TDI invites your input on the informal working draft. This is an informal posting intended to gather comments from stakeholders and the general public. It is not a formal publication for rulemaking.
