TRANSPORTATION INCIDENTS ARE THE NUMBER **ONE** CAUSE OF FATAL WORK-RELATED INJURIES IN TEXAS.



2015 TEXAS STATISTICS



45% of all fatal work injuries were caused by transportation incidents



56% of the work-related transportation fatalities involved occupations other than motor vehicle operators



43.8% of all people who died in vehicles in Texas were not wearing restraints
