Re: Extension until May 15, 2009 to submit Corrective Action Plans

Dear :

The Texas Department of Insurance sent a letter to all workers' compensation carriers and certified workers' compensation networks in the state of Texas on March 30, 2009. The letter addressed claims that occurred between the period of September 1, 2005 and the date that a claimant's employer elected to include network coverage in the employer's workers' compensation policy. The letter requires all carriers that have claims that were transitioned into a certified network without employer agreement or prior to the employer electing network coverage to submit a corrective action plan.

After careful review and consideration, the Commissioner of Insurance has granted an extension of the original April 20, 2009 due date until May 15, 2009 to all workers' compensation carriers and certified workers' compensation networks in the state of Texas to allow **sufficient time to submit complete corrective action plans** as required in the Department's letter dated March 30, 2009. The extension has been granted for the purposes of resolving questions and ensuring the smooth transition of claims as well as timely and effective implementation of corrective action plans.
