RE: Draft Forms: Implementing House Bill 2112

The Texas Department of Insurance, Division of Workers' Compensation (TDI-DWC) is accepting public comments on revisions to the following forms:

- *DWC Form-081, Agreement Between General Contractor and Subcontractor to Provide Workers' Compensation Insurance;*
- *DWC Form-082, Agreement for Motor Carriers and Owner Operators;*
- *DWC Form-083, Agreement for Certain Building and Construction Workers;*
- *DWC Form-084, Exception to Application of Joint Agreement for Certain Building and Construction Workers;* and,
- *DWC Form-085, Agreement Between General Contractor and Subcontractor to Establish Independent Relationship.*

In addition, TDI-DWC is removing the *DWC Form-065, Application for Inclusion on Registry of Private Providers of Vocational Rehabilitation Services*, and the *DWC Form-020, Insurance Carrier's Notice of Coverage/Cancellation/non-Renewal of Coverage*, from the TDI-DWC website.

TDI-DWC is amending and removing the forms simultaneously with the proposed amendments to 28 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §§ 110.105, 112.101, 112.102, 112.201, 112.202, 130.101, 130.102, and 136.1, and repeal of 28 TAC §130.10 and §136.2. The form amendments update language and formatting for consistency with the statutory and rule changes, and include additional non-substantive amendments for processing and clarity. In addition, removing the *DWC Form-065* and *DWC Form-020* eliminates forms that have become obsolete through rule and system changes.
