**ORDER ON MOTIONS FOR REHEARING**

**General remarks and official action taken:**

The subjects of this order are the motions for rehearing filed by Robert Duff Bourassa.

**Background**

On September 30, 2020, Commissioner's Order No. 2020-6494 was issued. The Order included findings of fact and conclusions of law and ordered that Robert Duff Bourassa's general lines insurance agent license with qualifications for property and casualty lines and life and health lines be revoked. The order was issued following a hearing on the merits of the proposed revocation of Mr. Bourassa's license and the issuance of a proposal for decision by the presiding administrative law judge.

Mr. Bourassa's counsel submitted a motion for rehearing after the issuance of the proposal for decision, but prior to issuance of Commissioner's Order No. 2020-6494.<sup>1</sup> On October 26, 2020, Mr. Bourassa's counsel submitted two additional motions for rehearing. The three motions for rehearing are substantially similar to each other because they raise the same issues and make the same arguments.
