## Self Funded ERISA vs Fully Funded Identification on cards

BCBS	For self-funded business, ID cards currently state that BCBSTX or HMO Blue Texas "provides administrative claims payment services only and assumes no financial risk with respect to claims." Specifically, Blue Cross/ Blue Shield of Texas ID cards on Traditional ASO, ASO-PPO, and ASO-POS accounts reflect this statement at the top of the reverse side of the ID card. HMO Blue Texas ID cards on ASO-"HMO" accounts carry this statement at the bottom of the reverse side of the ID card. Some group-specific ID cards may reflect slight variations to this statement or its placement, but the phrase "administrative claims payment services only" is the key indication of self-funded business.
Scott and White	Currently SWHP only has a handful of self-insured plans. They are identified on our ID cards by the reference to the group being "administered by SWHP". Our fully-insured groups do not have the "administered by" reference.
Texas Children's Health Plan	TCHP has an individual product - therefore we have no ERISA business.
