

**Texas Windstorm Insurance Association  
Proposed Revisions to  
Residential Insurance Policy Applications and Endorsements  
Reference Number P-0215-01**

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The Texas Windstorm Insurance Association has revised its:

- residential policy application (Link #S16616),
- residential policy renewal application (Link #S16618),
- residential policy loss payable clause endorsement (TWIA Form 112)(Link #S16611),
- residential policy premium assignment clause endorsement (TWIA Form 151-A)(Link #S16617),
- residential policy exclusion of cosmetic damage to roof endorsement (TWIA Form 420)(Link #S16615), and
- residential policy extension of coverage—increased cost of construction (dwelling) endorsement (TWIA Form 431)(Link #S16619).

TWIA submitted these filings to the Texas Department of Insurance for approval under Title 28 Texas Administrative Code §5.4911.

TWIA is implementing a new policy administration system that includes an online application process. The revised policy applications and endorsement forms are now online-formatted. The changes do not affect coverage.

TDI may act on the revised policy applications and endorsement forms after May 4, 2015.
