

General remarks and official action taken:

On December 20, 2018, the Commissioner of Insurance adopted findings of fact and conclusions of law and ordered that Arturo Mascorro's general lines agent license with a property and casualty qualification and adjuster all lines license be revoked. A default order was issued based on Mr. Mascorro's failure to appear in person or by legal representative at the hearing on the merits of the proposed revocation of his license.

On January 10, 2019, Mr. Mascorro filed a motion for rehearing of the matter, but his motion failed to articulate any alleged errors in the original order or underlying facts that would entitle him to a rehearing, and otherwise failed to satisfy the requirements of Government Code § 2001.146.

Therefore, the Commissioner of Insurance overrules and denies the Motion for Rehearing filed by Arturo Mascorro.
