ORDER APPROVING FINAL REPORT

On this day came on to be heard the *Final Report and Application to Terminate Receivership Proceeding and Discharge Receiver and Special Deputy Receiver* ("Application") filed by DKJ Group, Inc., Special Deputy Receiver of Texas Nations Title Agency, Inc. ("SDR" and "Texas Nations," respectively). The SDR appeared by and through its counsel. Having considered the Application, the Court finds as follows:

1. This Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this application under TEX. INS. CODE ANN. Chapter 443;
2. The Order of Reference entered by this Court on July 16, 2009 provides that applications filed pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE ANN. §§ 443.258 and 443.352 are referred to the Master;
3. The Application was submitted to the Master in accordance with the Order of Reference;
4. Notice of the Application was provided in accordance with TEX. INS. CODE ANN. §443.007 (d) and the Order of Reference, and no objections to the Application were filed;
5. The Master has issued a recommendation that the Application should be granted pursuant to Rule 171 of the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure; and
6. The recommendation of the Master should be confirmed, and the Application should be GRANTED in all respects.

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that:

1. All exhibits with the Application are admitted into evidence;
2. The Application is approved in all respects;
3. The final financial statements attached as Exhibits A, B, and C are accepted;
4. The Second Report of Claims attached as Exhibit E is approved;
5. The statement of expenses attached as Exhibit H is approved pursuant to TEX. INS.

CODE § 443.015;

6. The SDR is authorized to handle the Unclaimed Escrow Funds pursuant to §443.304;

7. The Commissioner of Insurance is authorized to retain or dispose of any records of Texas Nations pursuant to § 443.354(b);

8. The corporate existence of Texas Nations is dissolved;

9. The SDR is authorized to file the 2014 income tax return with the Internal Revenue Service;

10. Upon notice to the Court that the SDR has filed the 2014 income tax return with the Internal Revenue Service, the Court will issue its order discharging the Receiver and the SDR, terminating this proceeding and releasing the Receiver and the SDR from any further obligations in this proceeding; and

11. The Receiver and the SDR are authorized to take any actions and execute any documents as may be necessary to effectuate this Order.
