3. **If you are the insurance agent**, furnish a copy of this certificate to the **TEXAS WINDSTORM INSURANCE ASSOCIATION** along with the policy number or application.
4. **If you are the engineer** issuing notification of compliance for the property described on the face of this certificate, furnish this certificate to the **OWNER** and keep a copy.

This certificate should be kept in a safe place with all your other important documents.

Important: Any changes, additions, modifications, or repairs to this property of a structural nature will require another inspection and certificate of compliance to maintain eligibility for windstorm and hail insurance through the Texas Windstorm Insurance Association.
