


Why is DWC Transitioning?

- ▶ Federal Requirement to Use
 - Medical Billing, Processing, Reporting
 - ▶ Texas Labor Code Requires
 - CMS coding policies
 - ICD-10 is a CMS policy
 - ▶ Level I CPT and Level II HCPCS code sets are not affected
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When to Begin Using ICD-10

- ▶ CMS Transition Date
 - October 1, 2015
 - ▶ Outpatient Services
 - On or after CMS transition date
 - ▶ Inpatient Services
 - Discharge date on or after CMS transition date
 - Both diagnoses and procedure codes

How to Code Billing Form

- ▶ Before Transition Date
 - Enter 9 in Field 21
- ▶ After Transition Date
 - Enter 0 in Field 21



What to do Now

- ▶ Training for All
- ▶ Accommodate ICD-9 and ICD-10
 - Until transition date for DOS
- ▶ Test your Systems
- ▶ Stay Informed
- ▶ CMS Website
