Introduction

Claims Data

The Injuries and Claims section of this report includes information for lost workday claims only. This report does not include information relating to "medical only" claims. Lost workday claims only involve work-related injuries reported by employers with workers' compensation insurance that resulted in:

- * the employee's absence from work for more than one (1) day;
- * an occupational disease or illness (even if the employee was never absent from work); or
- * the employee's death.

Lost workday claims data is gathered by DWC through insurance carrier EDI claims reporting, DWC Form-001 (Employer's First Report of Injury or Illness), DWC Form-041 (Employee's Claim for Compensation for a Work-Related Injury or Occupational Disease), and DWC Form-042 (Claim for Workers' Compensation Death Benefits).

The number of claims per calendar year will continue to grow as injuries are reported or as injuries reported in the calendar year as "medical only" begin to lose time from work.

Each category must contain at least five claims to be displayed as a separate category. Specific categories with less than five claims will be identified as "N/A". These data restrictions protect the identity of individual injured employees (Texas Labor Code §402.090 permits the release of statistical information if the identity of an employee is not explicitly or implicitly disclosed).





for Calendar Year of Injury 2024**





for Calendar Year of Injury 2024**





Introduction

Income and Death Benefit Data

Income benefits replace a portion of an injured employee's wages lost due to a work-related injury or illness or compensate an injured employee for a permanent impairment caused by a work-related injury or illness. There are four types of income benefits:

- * Temporary Income Benefits (TIBs) - may be received by injured employees if their work-related injury or illness causes them to lose all or some of their wages for more than 7 days;
- * Impairment Income Benefits (IIBs) - may be received by injured employees if they have a permanent impairment from a work-related injury or illness;
- * Supplemental Income Benefits (SIBs) - may be received by injured employees if they meet specific eligibility requirements;
- * Lifetime Income Benefits (LIBs) - may be received by injured employees if their work-related injury results in a condition that entitles them to income benefits for their lifetime.
- * Death benefits replace a portion of lost family income for eligible family members of employees whose work-related injury or occupational illness results in a death.

Insurance carriers make claims-handling decisions to accept, deny, or pay income benefits. Insurance carriers report payment data to DWC when benefits are initiated, or suspended, and when there is a change in the type or amount of benefit. Each category must contain at least five claims to be displayed as a separate category. Specific categories with less than five claims will be identified as "N/A". These data restrictions are intended to help protect the identity of individual injured employees (Texas Labor Code §402.090 permits the release of statistical information if the identity of an employee is not explicitly or implicitly disclosed).

Introduction

Dispute Resolution Data

When parties have a disagreement related to a workers' compensation claim, they may request dispute resolution through the Texas Department of Insurance, Division of Workers' Compensation (DWC). There are several steps in the dispute resolution process:

- * Benefit Review Conference (BRC) - The BRC is an informal mediation held by videoconference.
- * Contested Case Hearing (CCH) - The CCH is a formal hearing conducted by a DWC administrative law judge who makes a decision about the disputed issue(s) that was not resolved at the BRC. A CCH may be at a local field office or held by videoconference.
- * Appeals Panel - If a party disagrees with the decision and order of the administrative law judge, the dissatisfied party may request review of the decision by the Appeals Panel.
- * Judicial Review - An injured employee or other parties may appeal the Appeals Panel decision to district court.

Except for the number of BRC requests received, the information found in this section is based on the outcome of the dispute at each level of the dispute resolution process. The number of BRC requests received may include disputes that are not yet concluded.

Proceedings shown are those involving questions on issues such as compensability/extent of injury, maximum medical improvement, impairment rating, etc.

Parties may hire an attorney to represent them and to give legal advice. The attorney may attend dispute resolution proceedings with the party and may present evidence and their side of the dispute. If an attorney is hired by an injured employee, the attorney's fees are deducted from the income benefit payments.

Injured employees may also be assisted by an ombudsman through the Office of Injured Employee Counsel (OIEC) at no charge.











By statute, designated doctors are doctors assigned by DWC to resolve specific issues, such as impairment rating (IR), maximum medical improvement (MMI), the extent of the compensable injury, the ability of an injured employee to return to work, etc. Because these doctors are selected by the state and receive special training and testing, designated doctors, by statute, have presumptive weight in DWC dispute proceedings. As a result, disputes regarding a designated doctor's report are not actually disputes in favor or against an injured employee but rather disputes in favor or against the designated doctor's report.

Medical Fee Dispute Data

A Medical Fee Dispute is a disagreement about the denial or reduction of reimbursement for compensable and medically necessary health care already provided for non-network claims. The parties involved in the disagreement may request medical fee dispute resolution through the TDI-DWC. Disagreements about the denial or reduction of reimbursement for health care on a certified network claim are handled between the health care provider and the certified network and are not resolved by TDI-DWC. Information found in this section is based on the outcome of the dispute for non-network claims.



Map of Number of Designated Doctor Appointments by County for Calendar Year 2024







Introduction

Medical Benefit Data

Medical benefits are health care services provided to injured employees. The information found in this section is based on date-of-service (i.e., the date the health care service or treatment was provided) and by the type of medical bill. The categories of health care services and treatment are as follows:

- * Professional - include the services of a medical professional, durable medical equipment provider, independent laboratory (not part of a hospital), and ambulance. This includes examinations that DWC ordered.
- * Hospital - include all services that an outpatient or inpatient hospital and ambulatory surgical centers bill.
- * Pharmacy - include the services of a dispensing pharmacy.
- * Dental - include professional dental services provided in the Texas Workers' Compensation system.
