General remarks and official action taken:

The subject of this default order is whether an adjuster all lines license should be issued to Carlos Lizardi, Jr (Respondent). Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Hearing filed by the Texas Department of Insurance. This order denies Respondent's license application.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

Failure to Respond to Notice of Hearing

- On February 5, 2020, the department filed a Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit
 A, and an Original Petition, attached as Exhibit B, with the State Office of
 Administrative Hearings.
- 2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.

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- The department sent the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department, McKinney, TX 75070-2492. The department sent an additional Notice of Hearing and Original Petition to Respondent's stated temporary address, Saylorsburg, PA 18353-8391.
- 4. Respondent failed to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing within 20 days of the date the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were mailed.

Conclusions of Law

- The commissioner has jurisdiction pursuant to Texas law, including Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4001.102, 4101.051, and 4005.101-4005.105; Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021-53.023; 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502; and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
- 2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally pursuant to Tex. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; Tex. Ins. CODE § 82.055; and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
- 3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing pursuant to Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054, and 28 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
- 4. Based on Respondent's failure to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default pursuant to 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
- 5. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true pursuant to 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.89.

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Order

It is ordered that Carlos Lizardi, Jr's application for an adjuster all lines license is denied. A copy of this order will be provided to law enforcement and/or other appropriate administrative agencies for further investigation as may be warranted.

ORIGINAL PETITION

The Texas Department of Insurance (Department) seeks to deny Carlos Lizardi Jr's (Lizardi) license application. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

Jurisdiction

The commissioner of insurance has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4005.101, 4005.102, 4101.051; Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178; 28 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 1.502; and Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021 – 53.023.

Factual Allegations

Criminal History

- On September 30, 1999, Lizardi was charged with Rape-2nd Degree, in Pittsford Town Criminal Court, Monroe County, New York in Case No. 01030291.
- Lizardi entered into a plea agreement in Case No. 01030291, in which he would serve three years concurrent probation sentences, for Sexual Misconduct and Endangering the Welfare of a Child.
- 3. In a letter to the Department dated April 18, 2018, Lizardi states that he has a New York City conviction for theft, in which he "cooperated with authorities", and had the record sealed.

License Application

- 4. On April 23, 2018, Lizardi submitted an application for an adjuster license.
- 5. The Department proposed to deny his application on September 20, 2018 based on Lizardi's criminal history.

Texas Criminal Equivalent

- 6. Lizardi's conviction for Sexual Misconduct in Case No. 01030291 contains the essential elements of Texas Penal Code Section 22.011(a)(1)(A), which criminalizes sexual assault as a felony in the second degree.
- 7. Lizardi's conviction for Endangering the Welfare of a Child in Case No. 01030291 contains the essential elements of Texas Penal Code Section 22.041(c), which criminalizes Abandoning or Endangering a Child as a state jail felony.

Legal Allegations

- 1. Lizardi committed a sexually violent offense, as defined by Article 62.001, Code of Criminal Procedures, as contemplated under Tex. Occ. Code § 53.021(a)(3).
- Lizardi was convicted of committing criminal acts with the essential elements to constitute felony offenses under Texas law, as contemplated under 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(e)(4)(B) and Tex. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(8).
- 3. Department guidelines, 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(d)-(e), emphasize that TDI:
 - a. may refuse to issue an original license if the department determines that the applicant has committed a misdemeanor that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation; and
 - b. considers the offenses of sexual misconduct and endangering the welfare of a child, to be of such a serious nature that it is of prime importance when determining fitness for licensure. 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502(e)(4)(B).

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Relief Sought

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, the Department asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

- 1. denying Lizardi's license application; and
- 2. granting any other just and appropriate relief to which the Department may be entitled to by law.
