General remarks and official action taken:

This is a default order taken against Jonathan Vasquez Luna (Respondent) because he: engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices; made a material misstatement in his license application; obtained or attempted to obtain a license by fraud or misrepresentation; has been convicted of a felony; and willfully violated an insurance law of this state. Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Hearing filed by the Texas Department of Insurance. This order revokes Respondent's license.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

Failure to Respond to Notice of Hearing

- 1. On June 10, 2020, the department filed a Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit A, and on June 8, 2020, the department filed an Original Petition, attached as Exhibit B, with the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
- 2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.

- The department sent the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department, Texas, 79015. The Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were also sent to an additional address associated with Respondent: Canyon, Texas 79015.
- 4. Respondent failed to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing within 20 days of the date the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were mailed.

Conclusions of Law

- 1. The commissioner has jurisdiction pursuant to Texas law, including TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, 4051.051, and 4054.051; and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
- 2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally pursuant to TEX. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; TEX. INS. CODE § 82.055; and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
- 3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing pursuant to TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054, and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
- 4. Based on Respondent's failure to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default pursuant to 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
- 5. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true pursuant to 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.89.

Order

It is ordered that Jonathan Vasquez Luna's general lines agent license with a life, accident, and health qualification and a property and casualty qualification is revoked.



ORIGINAL PETITION

The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to take disciplinary action against Jonathan Vasquez Luna. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

Jurisdiction

The commissioner of insurance has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, 4051.051, and 4054.051, and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051-2001.178.

Factual Allegations

Licensure

1. Jonathan Vasquez Luna (Luna), individual identification no. 1577167, holds a general lines agent license with a life, accident, and health qualification and a property and casualty qualification issued by the Texas Department of Insurance on April 7, 2016.

Criminal History

2. On October 19, 2016, Luna was indicted for Theft of Property greater than or equal to \$2,500 but less than \$30,000, a felony, in the 320th District Court of Potter County, Texas in case number 072581-D.

- 3. From approximately July 9, 2015, through January 13, 2016, Luna unlawfully acquired United States currency belonging to his employer without the consent of his employer.
- 4. On April 4, 2017, Luna was sentenced to two years deferred adjudication probation and ordered to pay \$10,122 in restitution. On April 30, 2019, Luna was successfully discharged from probation.

License Renewal

5. On or about July 12, 2018, Luna submitted an application for renewal of his insurance license. In the application, Luna answered "No" to the following question:

Have you been convicted of a felony, had a judgment withheld or deferred, or are you currently charged with committing a felony, which has not been previously reported to this insurance department?

6. Since Luna had already been placed on deferred adjudication probation at the time of his application, he misrepresented his criminal history to the department.

Cancelation of Appointments

- 7. On April 16, 2019, Luna's appointments with State Farm County Mutual Insurance Company of Texas, State Farm Fire and Casualty Company, State Farm General Insurance Company, State Farm Life Insurance Company, State Farm Lloyds, and State Farm Mutual Automobile Insurance Company, were canceled.
- 8. Since April 16, 2019, Luna has not held an active appointment and has not been actively engaged in soliciting or writing insurance.

Failure to Respond to Department Inquiries

9. The department made a written request for information pursuant to Section 38.001 of the Texas Insurance Code to Luna on February 5, 2019. While Luna initially attempted to provide a response, he failed to provide a complete response to the request by the 15th day after receiving the request or to send a written request for more time to respond.

10. The department made additional written requests for information pursuant to Section 38.001 of the Texas Insurance Code to Luna on June 20, 2019; August 21, 2019; and September 16, 2019. Luna failed to respond by the 15th day after receiving each of these requests or to send any written requests for more time to respond.

Legal Allegations

- 1. Luna has willfully violated an insurance law of this state, as contemplated by TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(1).
- 2. Luna made a material misstatement in his license application, in violation of TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(2).
- 3. Luna has obtained or attempted to obtain a license by fraud or misrepresentation, in violation of TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(3).
- 4. Luna has engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices, in violation of TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(5).
- 5. Pursuant to TEX. OCC. CODE § 53.021(d)(1)(B)(i) and (d)(2), Luna has been convicted of a felony, in violation of TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(8).
- 6. Luna committed an offense that the department considers to be of such serious nature that it is of prime importance in determining fitness for licensure, as contemplated by 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(e)(1), (3), and (4)(F).
- 7. Department guidelines, 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(c)-(e), emphasize that TDI:
 - a. considers it very important that license holders be honest, trustworthy, and reliable;
 - b. may revoke or refuse to renew a license if the department determines that the license holder has committed a felony or has engaged in fraudulent or dishonest activity that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation; and

- c. considers the offense of Theft of Property greater than or equal to \$2,500 but less than \$30,000, to be of such a serious nature that it is of prime importance when determining fitness for licensure. 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(e)(4)(F).
- 8. Luna is not actively engaged in soliciting or writing insurance for the public generally as required by Section 4001.104(a), in violation of TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(10).
- 9. Luna failed to respond no later than the 15th day after receiving an inquiry in writing from the department or to send a written request for more time to respond, in violation of TEX. INS. CODE § 38.001.

Relief Sought

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, the department asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

- 1. revoking Jonathan Vasquez Luna's license;
- 2. directing Jonathan Vasquez Luna to pay an administrative penalty under TEX. INS. CODE §§ 84.021 84.022; and
- 3. any other just and appropriate relief to which the Department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.
