General remarks and official action taken:

The subject of this default order is whether an Adjuster All Lines license should be issued to Misty Renee Anderson (Respondent). Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Hearing filed by the Texas Department of Insurance. This order denies Respondent's license application.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

Failure to Respond to Notice of Hearing

- On July 2, 2020, the department filed a Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit A, and an Original Petition, attached as Exhibit B, with the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
- 2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.
- 3. The department sent the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department,

, Houston, Texas 77040. The Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were also sent by electronic mail.

4. Respondent failed to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing within 20 days of the date the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were mailed.

Conclusions of Law

- 1. The commissioner has jurisdiction pursuant to Texas law, including Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4001.102, 4001.105, 4005.101-4005.105, and 4101.051; Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021-53.023; 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502; and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
- 2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally pursuant to Tex. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; Tex. Ins. CODE § 82.055; and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
- 3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing pursuant to Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054, and 28 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
- 4. Based on Respondent's failure to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default pursuant to 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
- 5. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true pursuant to 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.89.

Order

It is ordered that Misty Renee Anderson's application for an Adjuster All Lines license is denied. A copy of this order will be provided to law enforcement and/or other appropriate administrative agencies for further investigation as may be warranted.



FAILURE TO FILE A WRITTEN RESPONSE BY THIS DEADLINE SHALL ENTITLE TDI TO SEEK DISPOSITION BY DEFAULT PURSUANT TO 1 Tex. Admin. Code § 155.501 AND 28 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 1.88 AND 1.89.

ORIGINAL PETITION

The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to deny Misty Renee Anderson's license application. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

Jurisdiction

The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to TEX, INS, CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4101.051, and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.

Factual Allegations

License Application

- 1. On January 2, 2018, Misty Renee Anderson (Anderson) applied for an Adjuster All Lines license to be issued by the Texas Department of Insurance (TDI).
- 2. On April 2, 2018, TDI proposed to deny Anderson's application based on her criminal history. Anderson appealed that decision and made a written request for a hearing on April 9, 2018.

Criminal History

1. On May 14, 2001, Anderson pleaded guilty to the felony offense of Theft by Check in Cause No. 01-F-032-5 in the 5th Judicial District Court of Bowie County, Texas for

an offense occurring on February 16, 2000. Anderson was sentenced to two years confinement, suspended for five years of probation, and ordered to pay court costs. Anderson's probation was amended to ten years. Anderson was released from probation on June 9, 2011.

- 2. On April 16, 2001, Anderson pleaded guilty to the felony offense of Arkansas' Hot Check Law in Cause No. CR-2001-113-1 in the 8th District South Circuit Court of Miller County, Arkansas for an offense occurring between February 17, 2000, and March 18, 2000. Anderson received 36 months of Community Supervision. On April 13, 2004, a Petition for Revocation was filed against Anderson for violating the terms and conditions of her probation. A Motion to Withdraw Petition for Revocation was signed on June 17, 2010, based on Anderson's compliance.
- 3. On August 6, 2001, Anderson pleaded guilty to the felony offense of Forgery in Cause No. 136-CR601 in the 6th District Court of Red River County, Texas for an offense occurring on August 16, 2000. Anderson was originally sentenced to two years confinement probated for five years and a fine. On July 10, 2009, Anderson pleaded true to a Motion Revoking Community Supervision and was sentenced to 180 days confinement.
- 4. August 27, 2009, Anderson pleaded guilty to the felony offense of Hindering Secured Creditors in Cause No. 20268 in the 6th District Court of Lamar County, Texas for an offense occurring on April 24, 2004. Anderson was sentenced to 11 months confinement and ordered to pay court costs.

Legal Allegations

- 1. Anderson has committed an act for which a license may be denied pursuant to Tex. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b) because she has been convicted of a felony, as contemplated by Tex. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(8) and Tex. Occ. CODE § 53.021(d).
- 2. Anderson has committed a felony offense, as contemplated in 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.502(d) and (f).
- 3. Anderson committed an offense that TDI considers to be of such serious nature that it is of prime importance in determining fitness for licensure or authorization, as contemplated by 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(e)(4)(F).

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- 4. Department guidelines, 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(c)-(e), emphasize that TDI:
 - a. considers it very important that applicants be honest, trustworthy, and reliable;
 - b. may refuse to issue an original license if the department determines that the applicant has committed a felony or has engaged in fraudulent or dishonest activity that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation; and
 - c. considers the offense of Theft by Check, to be of such a serious nature that it is of prime importance when determining fitness for licensure. 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(e)(4)(F).
 - d. considers the offense of Forgery, to be of such a serious nature that it is of prime importance when determining fitness for licensure. 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(e)(1).

Relief Sought

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, the department asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

- 1. denying Misty Renee Anderson's license application and
- 2. any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.
