General remarks and official action taken:

The subject of this default order is whether a general lines agent license with a life, accident, and health qualification should be issued to Joy Marie Sonnier (Sonnier). Sonnier did not appear at the hearing on the merits. This order denies Sonnier's license application.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

Failure to Appear at Hearing on the Merits

- 1. On June 8, 2020, the Texas Department of Insurance filed a Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit A, and on June 5, 2020, an Original Petition, attached as Exhibit B, with the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
- 2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.
- 3. The department sent the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition to Sonnier's last known address provided in writing to the department,

77707-1817. The Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were also sent by electronic mail.

4. After receiving proper notice of the date, time, and location of the hearing on the merits, Sonnier failed to appear for the hearing on August 4, 2020, as shown in the record in SOAH Docket No. 454-20-3922.C.

Conclusions of Law

- 1. The commissioner has jurisdiction pursuant to Texas law, including Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 84.021-84.044, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4054.051; Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021-53.023; 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502; and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
- 2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally pursuant to Tex. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; Tex. Ins. CODE § 82.055; and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
- 3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing pursuant to Tex. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054, and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
- 4. Based on Sonnier's failure to appear in person or by legal representative at the hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default pursuant to 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
- 5. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true pursuant to 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.89.



ORIGINAL PETITION

The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to deny Joy Marie Sonnier's (Sonnier) license application. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

Jurisdiction

The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 84.021-82.044, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4054.051; 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502; Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021 – 53.023; and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.

Factual Allegations

License Application

- 1. On November 6, 2018, Sonnier applied for a general lines agent license with a life, accident, and health qualification to the department.
- 2. The department proposed to deny Sonnier's application on December 11, 2018, based on her criminal history. Sonnier appealed that decision and made a timely written request for a hearing.

Criminal History

- 3. On April 21, 2008, Sonnier pled guilty to burglary of a building, a state jail felony, in case number 08-02854 in the Criminal District Court of Jefferson County, Texas. Sonnier was placed on community supervision for five years, ordered to pay a fine of \$500.00, supervision fees of \$60.00 per month, court costs of \$215.00, PSI fee of \$350.00, attorney's fee of \$1,000.00, and a crime stoppers fee of \$50.00.
- 4. On August 18, 2008, Sonnier pled guilty to burglary of a vehicle, a class A misdemeanor offense, in the County Court at Law of Jefferson County, Texas in cause number 269148 and was sentenced to 30 days in jail.
- 5. On June 21, 2013, the Criminal District Court of Jefferson County, Texas entered a judgment adjudicating the guilt of Sonnier in case number 08-02854, based on Sonnier's pleas of true to counts 1, 2, 3, and 5 of the state's motion to adjudicate guilt. Sonnier committed the offense of injury to a child on or about January 20, 2012. Sonnier committed the offense of false report to a peace officer on or about January 30, 2012. Sonnier cohabitated with a person on felony probation. Sonnier failed to pay court assessed fees, and as of January 2, 2013, was \$4,499.00 in arrears. Sonnier was sentenced to two years incarceration in the State Jail Division of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice (TDCJ).
- 6. On July 14, 2014, Sonnier pled guilty to the offense of injury to a child, a first-degree felony, in case number 12-15729 in the Criminal District Court of Jefferson County, Texas. Sonnier was sentenced to five years incarceration in the Institutional Division of TDCJ. Sonnier was released from TDCJ on August 2, 2016 and discharged from parole on December 24, 2018.
- 7. Sonnier was convicted of one or more felonies involving dishonesty or breach of trust, as specified in 18 U.S.C. § 1033 and requires written consent from the commissioner of insurance to engage or participate in the business of insurance.

Legal Allegations

- 1. Sonnier committed acts for which a license may be denied because:
 - a. Based on her prior criminal history, she engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices, as contemplated by Tex. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(5).

- b. She committed a felony, as contemplated by Tex. Ins. Code § 4005.101(b)(8).
- 2. In accordance with the requirements of Texas Occupations Code § 53.025, the department has developed guidelines relating to the matters which the department will consider in determining whether to grant, deny, suspend, or revoke any license or authorization under its jurisdiction. 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502.
- 3. Sonnier committed an offense for which fraud, dishonesty, or deceit is an essential element, as contemplated in 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(e)(1) and Tex. Occ. CODE §§ 53.021-53.023.
- 4. Sonnier committed an offense with the essential elements of burglary, as contemplated in 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(e)(4)(F) and Tex. Occ. CODE §§ 53.021-53.023.
- 5. Department guidelines, 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502(c)-(e), emphasize that TDI:
 - a. Considers it very important that applicants be honest, trustworthy, and reliable;
 - b. May refuse to issue an original license if the department determines that the applicant has committed an offense that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation; and
 - c. Considers any offense for which fraud, dishonesty or deceit is an essential element, the offense of burglary, and the offense of injury to a child to be of prime importance when determining fitness for licensure.
- 6. Sonnier was convicted of a felony involving dishonesty or breach of trust, as specified in 18 U.S.C. § 1033 and requires written consent from the commissioner of insurance to engage or participate in the business of insurance.

Relief Sought

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, the department asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

1. Denying respondent's license application; and

2. Any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.


