General remarks and official action taken:

This is a default order taken against Brett Michael Fuksa (Respondent) because he violated insurance laws of this state, misappropriated insurance premiums, engaged in fraudulent and dishonest acts or practices, and engaged in the business of insurance without a license. Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Hearing filed by the Texas Department of Insurance. This order revokes Respondent's license and orders him to cease and desist engaging in the unauthorized business of insurance.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

Failure to Respond to Notice of Hearing

- 1. On July 29, 2020, the department filed a Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit A, and an Original Petition, attached as Exhibit B, with the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
- 2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.

- 3. The department sent the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department, Spring, TX 77379-2734. The Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were also sent by electronic mail to an address associated with Respondent.
- 4. Respondent failed to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing within 20 days of the date the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were mailed.

Conclusions of Law

- 1. The commissioner has jurisdiction pursuant to Texas law, including Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 84.021-84.044, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, 4051.051, and 4054.051; and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
- 2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally pursuant to Tex. Gov'T CODE § 2001.056; Tex. INS. CODE § 82.055; and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
- 3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing pursuant to Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054, and 28 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
- 4. Based on Respondent's failure to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default pursuant to 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
- 5. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true pursuant to 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.89.

Order

It is ordered that any licenses held by Brett Michael Fuksa are revoked. He is also ordered to cease and desist engaging in the unauthorized business of insurance under the name Bison Insurance and Financial Services, Inc. A copy of this order will be provided to law enforcement and/or other appropriate administrative agencies for further investigation as may be warranted.

ORIGINAL PETITION

The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to take disciplinary action against Brett Michael Fuksa. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

Jurisdiction

The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 84.021-84.044, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, 4051.051, 4054.051, and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.

Factual Allegations

Licensure and Background

- Brett Michael Fuksa (Brett), individual identification no. 864474, holds a general lines agent license with a property and casualty qualification and a life, accident, and health qualification, originally issued by the Texas Department of Insurance (department) on October 18, 2009.
- Brett's brother, Blaine Joseph Fuksa (Blaine), individual identification no. 1394486, previously held a general lines agent license with a property and casualty qualification and a life, accident, and health qualification, originally issued by the department on October 14, 2014. Blaine voluntarily surrendered his license to the department on July 22, 2019, to avoid administrative action.

- 3. Both Brett and Blaine were appointed by Farmers Insurance Companies (Farmers) until Farmers cancelled both of their appointments on July 27, 2018.
- 4. Blaine owned Bison Insurance and Financial Services, Inc. (Bison). Brett worked as an agent for Blaine at Bison.
- 5. Brett is engaging or has engaged in the business of insurance through Bison. Bison has an active website in which Brett is listed as the only contact. Bison has never been licensed or registered with the department.

Dishonest/Fraudulent Conduct

- 6. An internal investigation by Farmers revealed Brett processed 64 electronic funds transfer payments using invalid bank account information. Fifty-three were processed for new policies and reinstatements, and 11 were processed to prevent cancellation of policies. These 64 electronic funds transfer payments impacted 28 policies on 18 billing accounts for 14 customers.
- 7. Nine of the 18 impacted billing accounts were billed to the Bison office address. None of the cancelation or reinstatement correspondence sent by Farmers to these nine billing accounts reached the customers.
- 8. The 28 impacted policies included 16 fictitious automobile and homeowner's policies issued by Brett. These policies were issued with invalid bank account information. After the policies were cancelled for nonpayment, Brett processed additional payments with invalid bank account information to reinstate them.
- 9. In one example, an unauthorized policy was issued May 2017 with invalid bank account information. When the policy was canceled for nonpayment, an additional electronic funds transfer payment was processed to reinstate it. Between May 2017 and June 2018, the policy was canceled seven times and each time was reinstated with invalid bank account information. This policy was never requested by the customer and the billing address for this billing account was the Bison office address.
- 10. One customer, N.P., had an automobile policy for two years with Bison. N.P. canceled the policy and moved to a different agent and insurer. Without N.P.'s knowledge or consent, Brett reinstated the automobile policy and withdrew \$800

from N.P.'s bank account to pay the premium. Farmers refunded the premium to N.P.

11. The invalid electronic funds transfers processed by Brett resulted in a total of \$24,899 in unearned commissions paid to Bison. Farmers recovered the funds via chargebacks to Bison and Brett.

Legal Allegations

- 1. Brett committed acts for which a license holder may be disciplined under Tex. INS. CODE § 4005.101, as contemplated in Tex. INS. CODE § 4005.102.
- 2. Brett willfully violated an insurance law of this state, pursuant to Tex. Ins. Code § 4005.101(b)(1).
- 3. Brett misappropriated, converted to his own use, or illegally withheld money belonging to an insurer or an insured, pursuant to Tex. Ins. Code § 4005.101(b)(4).
- 4. Brett engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices, pursuant to Tex. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(5).
- 5. Brett engaged in acts constituting the business of insurance without a license, as defined in Tex. Ins. Code §§ 101.051 and 4001.051, in violation of Tex. Ins. Code §§ 101.102, 4001.101, 4051.051, 4054.051, and 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 19.902.
- 6. Brett failed to register an assumed name by filing with the department a completed form LDTL together with the required fee, in violation of 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 19.902.

Relief Sought

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, the department asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

1. revoking Brett Michael Fuska's license;



- 2. directing Brett Michael Fuska to pay an administrative penalty under Tex. INS. CODE §§ 84.021-84.022;
- 3. directing Brett Michael Fuksa to cease and desist conducting the business of insurance under the name Bison Insurance and Financial Services, Inc., an unlicensed entity; and
- 4. any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.
