General remarks and official action taken:

This is a default order taken against Candace Marie Segall (Respondent) because she engaged in fraudulent or dishonest practices and engaged in dishonest activity that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation. Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Hearing filed by the Texas Department of Insurance. This order revokes Respondent's license.


The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

Failure to Respond to Notice of Hearing

- On October 14, 2020, the department filed a Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit
 A, and an Original Petition, attached as Exhibit B, with the State Office of
 Administrative Hearings.
- 2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.

4. Respondent failed to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing within 20 days of the date the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were mailed.

Conclusions of Law

- 1. The commissioner has jurisdiction pursuant to Texas law, including Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, 4051.051, 4054.051, Tex. Gov'T Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178, 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502, and Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021-53.023.
- 2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally pursuant to Tex. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; Tex. Ins. CODE § 82.055; and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
- 3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing pursuant to Tex. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054, and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
- 4. Based on Respondent's failure to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default pursuant to 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
- 5. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true pursuant to 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.89.

ORIGINAL PETITION

The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to take disciplinary action against Candace Marie Segall. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

Jurisdiction

The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, 4051.051, 4054.051, Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178, 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502, and Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021-53.023.

Factual Allegations

<u>Criminal History Prior to Licensure</u>

- On November 6, 2012, Candace Marie Segall (Segall) was indicted for Theft of Property, with a value of \$50 or more, but less than \$500, a Class B misdemeanor, in case number 12-282869, in the County Court at Law No. 4 of Montgomery County, Texas. Segall pled guilty on December 10, 2012, and received deferred adjudication, with one year of community supervision.
- 2. In case number 12-282869, a condition of Segall's community supervision stipulated that she commit no offense against the laws of Texas, or any other state, or of the United States. Segall was also required to pay \$15 to Crime Stoppers of Montgomery County within 45 days of the order.

- 3. In case number 12-282869, a Motion to Adjudicate was filed on April 29, 2013. The Motion alleged that Segall committed Burglary of a Habitation on December 19, 2012, failed to pay the required installments set forth in the collection agreement, and failed to pay the Crime Stoppers Fee in the amount of \$15 to the Montgomery County Department of Community Supervision. Segall entered a plea of true.
- 4. On April 3, 2014, an order adjudicating Segall's guilt was entered in case number 12-282869. As a result, Segall was found guilty of Theft of Property, a Class B misdemeanor, and sentenced to 30 days in the Montgomery County Jail and received a fine of \$700.
- 5. On September 5, 2013, Segall was indicted by a grand jury for intentionally or knowingly entering a habitation, without the effective consent of the resident, with the intent to commit theft and attempted to commit or committed theft, a second degree felony, in case number 13-04-03848-CR, in the 410th District Court of Montgomery County, Texas.
- 6. Segall pled guilty to the second degree felony of Burglary of a Habitation in case number 13-04-03848-CR. On February 28, 2014, Segall received deferred adjudication with seven years of community supervision.

Suspended License Due to Criminal History

- 7. Segall disclosed her prior offenses to the department when she applied for licensure with the department in November 2015.
- 8. On March 18, 2016, Segall was granted a general lines agent license with a property and casualty qualification by the department under individual identification number 1465095. Because of Segall's criminal history, the department chose to issue that license subject to an immediate probated suspension for a period of two years.
- 9. Segall agreed to this probated suspension and its terms and conditions, which included providing immediate notification to the department of any information, indictment, or other instrument issued against Segall for any misdemeanor or felony offense, excluding traffic offenses and Class C misdemeanors, during the period of the probated license.

- 10. Segall acknowledged that if she was charged, convicted, or placed on probation for any additional criminal offenses, the license issued to her may be revoked after a public hearing.
- 11. On November 29, 2016, Segall was released from community supervision in case number 13-04-03848-CR, and her deferred adjudication was terminated.
- 12. The term of Segall's probated license suspension expired on March 18, 2018.
- 13. On April 12, 2018, the department approved Segall's application for issuance of a life, accident, health, and HMO qualification to be added to her general lines license.

New Criminal Offense is Dishonest Activity

- 14. Only one year after the probated suspension expired, Segall was indicted on April 8, 2019, for Theft of Property with a value of \$100 or more, but less than \$750, a misdemeanor, in case number 19-340263, in the County Court at Law No. 5, Montgomery County, Texas.
- 15. Due to Segall's prior misdemeanor conviction for theft in case number 12-282869, the misdemeanor in case number 19-340263 was enhanced to a Class A misdemeanor. Segall pled guilty to the Class A misdemeanor of Theft of Property and received deferred adjudication on July 30, 2019, with nine months of community supervision and a \$600 fine.
- 16. On May 6, 2020, Segall completed her period of community supervision in case number 19-340263 and was discharged.

Legal Allegations

- 1. Because Segall already held a license at the time of her new offense, the department cannot consider her newest offense to be a conviction under Tex. Occ. CODE § 53.021(d)(1)(B)(i).
- 2. However, Segall has engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices, in violation of Tex. Ins. Code § 4005.101(b)(5).

- 3. Segall engaged in dishonest activity that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation, in violation of 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(d) and (g).
- 4. Segall engaged in dishonest activity that the department considers to be of such a serious nature that it is of prime importance in determining fitness for licensure, as contemplated by 28 Tex Admin. Code § 1.502(e)(1) and (e)(4)(F).
- 5. Department guidelines, 28 TEX ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(c)-(e), emphasize that the department:
 - a. considers it very important that license holders be honest, trustworthy, and reliable;
 - b. may revoke or suspend a license if the department determines that the holder has engaged in fraudulent or dishonest activity that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation; and
 - c. considers the offense of Theft of Property to be of such a serious nature that it is of prime importance when determining fitness for licensure. 28 TEX ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(e)(1) and (e)(4)(F).

Relief Sought

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, the department asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

- 1. revoking Candace Marie Segall's license;
- 2. alternatively, suspending Candace Marie Segall's license without probation; and
- 3. imposing any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.
