General remarks and official action taken:

The subject of this default order is whether an adjuster all lines license should be issued to Jose Edward Ortega (Respondent). Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Hearing filed by the Texas Department of Insurance. This order denies Respondent's license application.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

Failure to Respond to Notice of Hearing

- On October 28, 2020, the department filed a Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit
 A, and an Original Petition, attached as Exhibit B, with the State Office of
 Administrative Hearings.
- 2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.
- The department sent the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department,

Garland, Texas 75040. The Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were also sent by electronic mail and to two additional addresses associated with Respondent:

4. Respondent failed to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing within 20 days of the date the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were mailed.

Conclusions of Law

- 1. The commissioner has jurisdiction pursuant to Texas law, including Tex. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4101.051, and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
- 2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally pursuant to Tex. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; Tex. Ins. CODE § 82.055; and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
- 3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing pursuant to Tex. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054, and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
- 4. Based on Respondent's failure to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default pursuant to 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
- 5. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true pursuant to 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.89.

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Order

It is ordered that Jose Edward Ortega's application for an adjuster all lines license is denied. A copy of this order will be provided to law enforcement and/or other appropriate administrative agencies for further investigation as may be warranted.

ORIGINAL PETITION

The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to deny Jose Edward Ortega's license application. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

Jurisdiction

The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4101.051, and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.

Factual Allegations

Prior Licensure

- 1. Under individual identification number 1369801, Jose Edward Ortega (Ortega) previously held personal lines property and casualty agent license issued by the department on August 15, 2014.
- 2. Ortega's license expired on September 28, 2016. Ortega did not renew his license.

License Application

3. On December 1, 2017, Ortega submitted an application to the department for an adjuster all lines license.

4. The department proposed to deny Ortega's application on March 14, 2018, because he may have committed an act for which a license may be denied under Tex. Ins. Code § 4005.101. Ortega appealed that decision and made a written request for a hearing.

Misconduct During Previous Licensure

- 5. Between August 27, 2014, and May 21, 2015, Ortega was appointed with seven GEICO affiliated insurance companies.
- 6. GEICO cancelled Ortega's appointments for cause effective March 4, 2016, alleging that Ortega issued falsified policies.
- 7. During an investigation, GEICO found that Ortega falsified 75 insurance policies using data from actual customers.
- 8. Ortega used the routing and account number of his personal bank account as the payment method for many of the falsified policies. He also used customer banking information acquired from prior customer transactions to issue falsified policies.
- 9. Ortega would request cancellation of the falsified policies before any payments were withdrawn from his personal bank account or the customer's banking account.
- 10. During GEICO's internal investigation, Ortega admitted his actions.
- 11. In 2016, the department investigated Ortega's conduct based on GEICO's allegations.
- 12. During that investigation, Ortega's license expired and as a result, the department closed its investigation.

Attempted to Obtain a License by Misrepresentation

13. The application Ortega submitted to the department on December 1, 2017, asked, "Have you or any business in which you are or were an owner, partner, officer or director, or member or manager of a limited liability company, ever had an

insurance agency contract or any other business relationship with an insurance company terminated for any alleged misconduct?"

14. Ortega answered "no," which was a false answer because he had been cancelled for cause by multiple GEICO companies in 2016.

Legal Allegations

- 1. Ortega has committed acts for which the department may deny a license application pursuant to Tex. Ins. Code §§ 4005.101 and 4005.102 because he:
 - a. Intentionally made a material misstatement in his licensing application, in violation of Tex. Ins. Code § 4005.101(b)(2).
 - b. Attempted to obtain a license by fraud or misrepresentation, in violation of Tex. Ins. Code § 4005.101(b)(3).
 - c. Engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices, in violation of Tex. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(5).

Relief Sought

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, the department asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

- 1. denying Jose Edward Ortega's license application and
- 2. imposing any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law.
