#### General remarks and official action taken:

This is a default order taken against Valerie Elaine Pennywell (Respondent) because she intentionally made a material misstatement in her license application, obtained a license by fraud or misrepresentation, engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices, willfully violated an insurance law of this state, failed to notify the Texas Department of Insurance (the department) of administrative actions taken against her by insurance regulators of other states, and is not actively engaged in soliciting or writing insurance for the public. Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Hearing filed by the department. This order revokes Respondent's license.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

# **Findings of Fact**

#### Failure to Respond to Notice of Hearing

1. On October 28, 2020, the department filed a Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit A, and an Original Petition, attached as Exhibit B, with the State Office of Administrative Hearings.

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- 2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.
- 3. The department sent the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department, , Georgia 30039-8657. The Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were also sent by electronic mail.
- 4. Respondent failed to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing within 20 days of the date the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were mailed.

#### **Conclusions of Law**

- 1. The commissioner has jurisdiction pursuant to Texas law, including Tex. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, 4051.401, and 4056.052, and Tex. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
- 2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally pursuant to Tex. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; Tex. Ins. CODE § 82.055; and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
- 3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing pursuant to Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054, and 28 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
- 4. Based on Respondent's failure to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default pursuant to 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
- 5. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true pursuant to 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.89.

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#### Order

It is ordered that any licenses held by Valerie Elaine Pennywell are revoked. A copy of this order will be provided to law enforcement and/or other appropriate administrative agencies for further investigation as may be warranted.



Unless otherwise directed by the Administrative Law Judge, the hearing shall continue from day to day in the offices of the State Office of Administrative Hearings until concluded. You have the right to appear at this hearing and to be represented by an attorney.

Parties that are not represented by an attorney may obtain information regarding contested case hearings on the public website of the State Office of Administrative Hearings at www.soah.texas.gov, or in printed format upon request to SOAH.

YOU MUST FILE A WRITTEN RESPONSE TO THE NOTICE OF HEARING WITH THE STATE OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS WITHIN 20 DAYS OF THE DATE THE NOTICE OF HEARING WAS MAILED. FAILURE TO FILE A WRITTEN RESPONSE BY THIS DEADLINE SHALL ENTITLE TDI TO SEEK DISPOSITION BY DEFAULT PURSUANT TO 1 Tex. Admin. Code § 155.501 AND 28 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 1.88 AND 1.89.

#### ORIGINAL PETITION

The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to take disciplinary action against Valerie Elaine Pennywell. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

#### **Jurisdiction**

The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, 4051.401 and 4056.052, and Tex. Gov'T Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.

# **Factual Allegations**

#### Licensure

1. Under individual identification number 2066537, Valerie Elaine Pennywell (Pennywell) holds a non-resident personal lines property and casualty agent license, originally issued by the department on May 21, 2019.

# <u>Undisclosed Criminal History</u>

2. On December 18, 1986, Pennywell pled nolo contendre to the charge of Grand Theft, a third-degree felony, in Case Number 85-2627, before the Circuit Court in and for Leon County, Florida. Adjudication of guilt was withheld and she was sentenced to eighteen months probation, and ordered to pay court costs and fines. On June 19, 1988, Pennywell completed her sentence.

3. In Pennywell's Texas insurance license application, filed on May 21, 2019, she answered "No" to the following question: "Have you ever been convicted of a felony, had a judgment withheld or deferred, or are you currently charged with committing a felony?"

# <u>Unreported Administrative Actions by Other Insurance Regulators</u>

- 4. On August 27, 2019, Pennywell was the subject of an administrative action taken by the Licensing Bureau of the Florida Department of Financial Services (Florida). In this action, Florida issued a Notice of Denial of Pennywell's license application.
- 5. The Florida denial was based upon Pennywell's 1986 criminal offense and disposition, and her May 21, 2019, submission of a license application to Florida in which she answered "No" to the question: "Have you ever been convicted of a felony, had a judgment withheld or deferred, or are you currently charged with committing a felony?"
- 5. Pennywell did not notify the department of the Florida license denial.
- 6. On April 23, 2020, the Louisiana Commissioner of Insurance (Louisiana), issued a Notice of Revocation Order against Pennywell. The Louisiana Order revoked Pennywell's Louisiana license, after finding that:
  - a. Florida denied Pennywell's license application on August 27, 2019, due to her criminal history and a false response on her license application;
  - b. Pennywell failed to disclose this action to Louisiana within thirty days; and
  - c. Pennywell failed to respond to Louisiana's inquiries.
- 7. Pennywell did not notify the department of the Louisiana revocation.

# Not Actively Engaged in the Business of Insurance

- 8. On October 8, 2019, a group of four affiliated insurers cancelled Pennywell's appointments with them.
- 9. Pennywell has held no other appointments with any insurer in Texas, and presently has no active appointments in Texas.

# **Legal Allegations**

- 1. Pennywell has committed an act for which a license holder may be disciplined under Tex. Ins. Code §§ 4005.101 and 4005.102 because she:
  - a. willfully violated an insurance law of this state, in violation of Tex. Ins. Code § 4005.101(b)(1);
  - b. intentionally made a material misstatement in the license application, in violation of Tex. Ins. Code § 4005.101(b)(2);
  - c. obtained a license by fraud or misrepresentation, in violation of Tex. Ins. CODE § 4005.101(b)(3);
  - d. engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices, in violation of Tex. INS. Code § 4005.101(b)(5);
  - e. is not actively engaged in soliciting or writing insurance for the public generally as required by Tex. Ins. Code § 4001.104(a), in violation of Tex. Ins. Code § 4005.101(b)(10); and
  - f. did not notify the department of the administrative actions taken against her by insurance regulators of other states, in violation of Tex. INS. CODE § 4001.252(a)(3).
- 2. Pennywell committed an offense and has engaged in fraudulent or dishonest activity that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation, as contemplated in 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502(d) and (f).
- 3. Pennywell committed an offense the department considers to be of such serious nature that it is of prime importance in determining fitness for licensure or authorization, as contemplated by 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(e).
- 4. Department guidelines, 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(c)-(e), emphasize that the department:
  - a. considers it very important that applicants be honest, trustworthy, and reliable;

- b. may revoke a license if the department determines that the licensee has committed an offense that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation; and
- c. considers any offense for which fraud, dishonesty, or deceit is an essential element to be of prime importance.

#### **Relief Sought**

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, the department asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

- 1. revoking Pennywell's license, and
- 2. imposing any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.
