General remarks and official action taken:

This is a default order taken against Daniel Cortez Jr. (Respondent) because he misappropriated premiums and converted them to his own use. Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Hearing filed by the Texas Department of Insurance. This order revokes Respondent's license.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

Failure to Respond to Notice of Hearing

- On November 13, 2020, the department filed a Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit A, and an Original Petition, attached as Exhibit B, with the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
- 2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.
- The department sent the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department, PO Box 512, Elsa, TX

78543. The Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were also sent by electronic mail.

4. Respondent failed to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing within 20 days of the date the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were mailed.

Conclusions of Law

- 1. The commissioner has jurisdiction pursuant to Texas law, including Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4001.102, 4001.105, 4005.101-4005.105, and 4101.051 and 4054.051; Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021-53.023; 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502; and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
- 2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally pursuant to Tex. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; Tex. Ins. CODE § 82.055; and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
- 3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing pursuant to Tex. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054, and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
- 4. Based on Respondent's failure to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default pursuant to 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
- 5. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true pursuant to 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.89.

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Order

It is ordered that any licenses held by Daniel Cortez Jr. are revoked. A copy of this order will be provided to law enforcement and/or other appropriate administrative agencies for further investigation as may be warranted.

ORIGINAL PETITION

The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to take disciplinary action against Daniel Cortez Jr. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

Jurisdiction

The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4054.051, and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.

Factual Allegations

- 1. Daniel Cortez Jr. (Cortez) holds a general lines license with a life, accident health and HMO qualification that was issued by the Department on January 26, 2018.
- 2. Cortez was employed as an agent by American National Insurance Company from October 16, 2017, until August 24, 2018.
- 3. Cortez collected premiums totaling \$1,343.35 and then failed to remit the money to American National Insurance Company.
- 4. American National Insurance Company terminated the appointment of Cortez for this misconduct.

5. The Department sent a request for information to Cortez on November 12, 2019, regarding these allegations and Cortez failed to timely respond.

Legal Allegations

- 1. Cortez has committed acts for which a license holder may be disciplined under TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101, as contemplated in TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.102.
- 2. Cortez has misappropriated or converted for his own use money belonging to an insured or insurer, as contemplated by Tex. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(4).
- 3. Cortez has engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices, as contemplated by Tex. Ins. Code § 4005.101(b)(5).
- 4. Cortez failed to timely respond to a written inquiry pursuant to Tex. INS. CODE § 38.001.
- 5. According to TDI records, Cortez does not have any active appointments and therefore is not actively engaged in the business of insurance as required by Tex. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(10).

Relief Sought

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, the department asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

- 1. revoking Daniel Cortez Jr.'s license;
- 2. directing Daniel Cortez Jr. to make restitution to the victim under Tex. Ins. Code § 82.053; and
- 3. imposing any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.
