# Official Order of the Texas Commissioner of Insurance

## **Subject Considered:**

#### General remarks and official action taken:

This is a consent order with Trupanion Managers USA, Inc. (Trupanion). Trupanion, previously named Vetinsurance Managers, Inc. (Vetinsurance), used unlicensed individuals to write pet insurance policies in Texas. Trupanion has agreed to pay an administrative penalty of \$75,000.

#### Waiver

Trupanion acknowledges that the Texas Insurance Code and other applicable law provide certain rights. Trupanion waives all of these rights, and any other applicable procedural rights, in consideration of the entry of this consent order.

## **Findings of Fact**

## Licensure and Appointment

1. Trupanion, firm identification no. 9588590, is a nonresident general lines agency with a property and casualty qualification, issued by the Texas Department of Insurance on February 14, 2008.

# Unlicensed Call Center Employees

- 2. Trupanion, doing business as Vetinsurance, allowed 87 unlicensed employees to sell 937 pet insurance policies to Texas consumers for a 17-month period.
- 3. Trupanion represents that it has come into compliance with Texas insurance laws, and all employees selling pet insurance policies to Texas residents in the company's call center are now properly licensed by the department.
- 4. Trupanion has entered into consent orders based on the sale of pet insurance policies by its unlicensed employees with the insurance regulators of the following states: Louisiana, Massachusetts, New York, Maine, and California.
- 5. Trupanion notified all U.S. insurance regulators, including the department, of disciplinary action taken against it in a timely manner by self-reporting through the National Insurance Producer's Registry.

## Unlicensed Sales Agents

- 6. During the course of its investigation, the department was made aware of Trupanion's use of unlicensed sales agents known as "Territory Partners" to engage veterinary clinics and hospitals for the purpose of having them advertise Trupanion's products.
- 7. Trupanion represented to the department that Territory Partners have the following job responsibilities: (1) initiate and maintain relationships with area veterinary clinics; (2) promote the insurance products sold by Trupanion; (3) request that the veterinary clinics display Trupanion's product advertisements; and (4) conduct meetings with the veterinary clinics to help them familiarize themselves with the products.
- 8. Territory Partners acted as insurance agents when they disseminated the information regarding Trupanion's coverage and rates to the veterinary clinics and hospitals, which would then be advertised in the vet offices to pet owners.

- 9. The Territory Partners were also paid commission-based wages for their sales activities. The Territory Partners were paid a flat fee based on the number of sales of individual pet insurance policies in their territory.
- 10. Because the sales activities and commission-based wages fall under conduct that constitutes the business of insurance, Trupanion was instructed by the department that their sales agents would need to be licensed as well.
- 11. Trupanion represented to the department that all Territory Partners are now licensed agents in the State of Texas.

# **Conclusions of Law**

- 1. The commissioner has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051–82.055, 84.021–84.044, 101.051, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4051.051, and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
- 2. The commissioner has the authority to informally dispose of this matter as set forth in TEX. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; TEX. INS. CODE § 36.104 and 82.055; and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.
- 3. Trupanion has knowingly and voluntarily waived all procedural rights to which it may have been entitled regarding the entry of this order, including, but not limited to, issuance and service of notice of intention to institute disciplinary action, notice of hearing, a public hearing, a proposal for decision, rehearing by the commissioner, and judicial review.
- 4. Trupanion employed individuals who sold pet insurance policies without holding a license or authorization from the department in violation of TEX. INS. CODE §§ 101.051, 4001.101, 4051.051, and 4005.101.

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## Order

As a result of Trupanion's call center employees selling pet insurance policies to Texas consumers (Findings of Fact 2-5 above), it is ordered that Trupanion Managers USA, Inc. pay an administrative penalty of \$75,000 within 30 days from the date of this order. The administrative penalty must be paid by company check made payable to the "State of Texas" and transmitted to the Texas Department of Insurance, Attn: Enforcement Division 60851, MC 9999, P.O. Box 149104, Austin, Texas 78714-9104.

It is further ordered that Trupanion ensure that all call center employees who sell insurance policies to Texas consumers remain duly licensed to do so, and that all Territory Partners in Texas similarly remain licensed in the State of Texas.
