General remarks and official action taken:

This is a default order taken against Ellis B. Cooper (Respondent) because he engaged in fraudulent or dishonest practices that resulted in his license being revoked in his resident state of Rhode Island and he failed to notify the department of that administrative action. Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Hearing filed by the Texas Department of Insurance. This order revokes Respondent's license.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

Failure to Respond to Notice of Hearing

- On December 3, 2020, the department filed a Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit
 A, and an Original Petition, attached as Exhibit B, with the State Office of
 Administrative Hearings.
- 2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.

- 3. The department sent the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department, Woodsocket, RI 02895-6220. The Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were also sent by electronic mail to Respondent.
- 4. Respondent failed to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing within 20 days of the date the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were mailed.

Conclusions of Law

- 1. The commissioner has jurisdiction pursuant to Texas law, including Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4001.102, 4001.105, 4005.101-4005.105, 4051.051 and 4101.051; Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021-53.023; 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502; and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
- 2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally pursuant to Tex. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; Tex. Ins. Code § 82.055; and 28 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
- 3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing pursuant to Tex. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054, and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
- 4. Based on Respondent's failure to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default pursuant to 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
- 5. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true pursuant to 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.89.

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Order

It is ordered that any licenses held by Ellis B. Cooper are revoked. A copy of this order will be provided to law enforcement and/or other appropriate administrative agencies for further investigation as may be warranted.

ORIGINAL PETITION

The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to take disciplinary action against Ellis B. Cooper. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

Jurisdiction

The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4051.051, and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.

Factual Allegations

- 1. Ellis B. Cooper (Cooper), individual identification number 1697285, holds a general lines license with a property and casualty qualification issued by the Department on December 8, 2016.
- 2. Cooper held an insurance license in his resident state of Rhode Island, which was revoked on August 12, 2020, for paying a named insured as an inducement to the insurance and for rebating premiums payable on the policy.
- 3. Cooper holds an insurance license in the state of Indiana which was suspended on July 1, 2020, for demonstrating lack of fitness or trustworthiness.
- 4. Cooper failed to notify the Department of the administrative actions taken against him by Rhode Island and Indiana.

Legal Allegations

- 1. Cooper engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices, as contemplated by Tex. Ins. Code § 4005.101(b)(5).
- 2. Cooper offered or gave a rebate of an insurance premium or commission to an insured or enrollee, as contemplated by Tex. Ins. Code § 4005.101(b)(9).
- Cooper directly, or indirectly paid, allowed, gave, or offered to pay, allow or give
 as an inducement to insurance a thing of value or other inducement that is not
 specified in the policy, in violation of Tex. Ins. Code § 543.003
- 4. Cooper failed to notify the Department, on a monthly basis, of an administrative action taken against her by an insurance regulator of another state as required by Tex. Ins. Code § 4001.252(a)(2).

Relief Sought

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, the department asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

- 1. revoking Ellis B. Cooper's license and
- 2. imposing any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.
